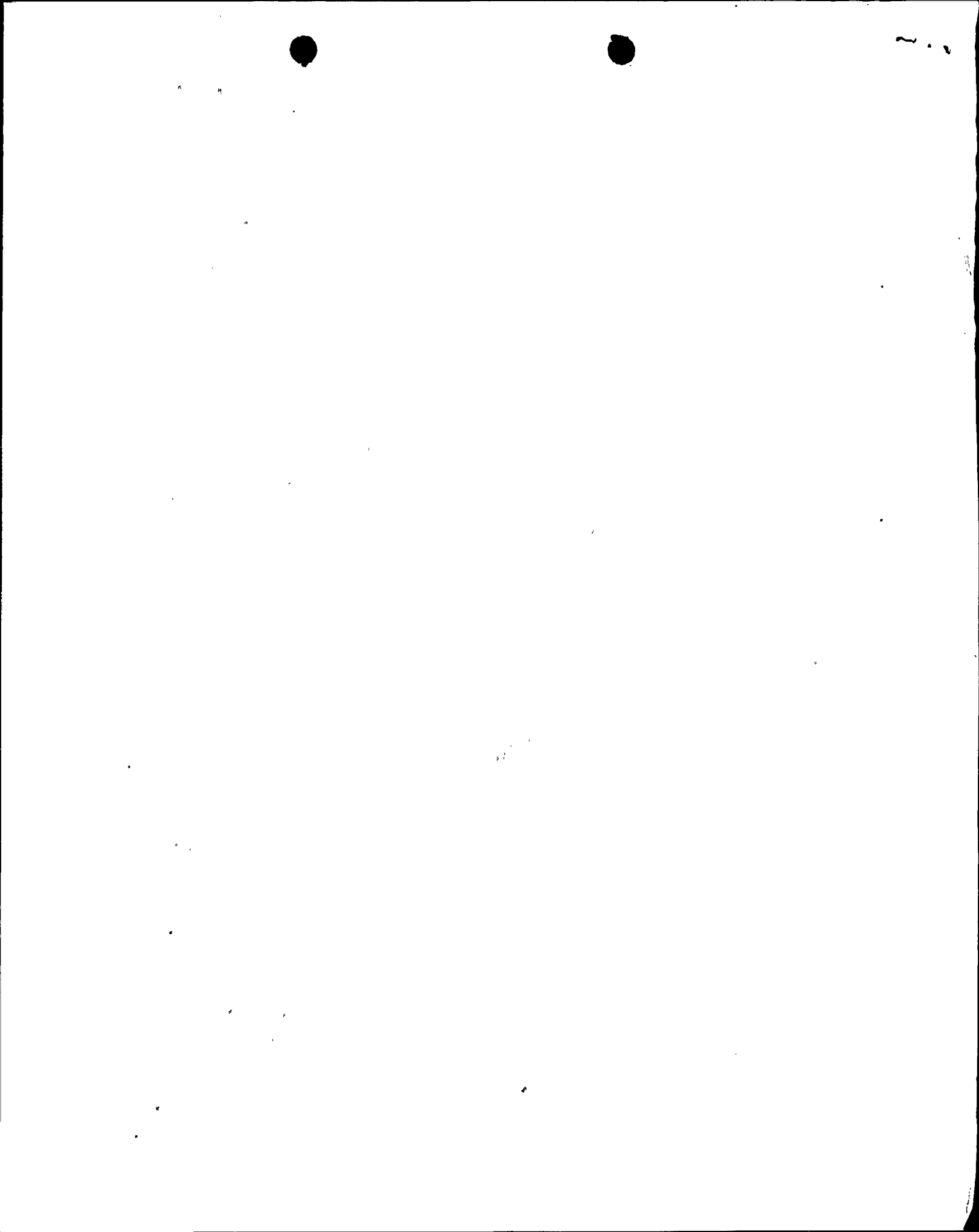

In an order dated January 25, 1974 the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board designated to rule on petitions for leave to intervene admitted as parties to this proceeding, among others, John J. Forster and Lonnie Valentine. Subsequently, Mr. Lonnie Valentine voluntarily withdrew from the proceeding.

PGandE is informed that Mr. John J. Forster no longer resides in San Luis Obispo or even in the State of California. 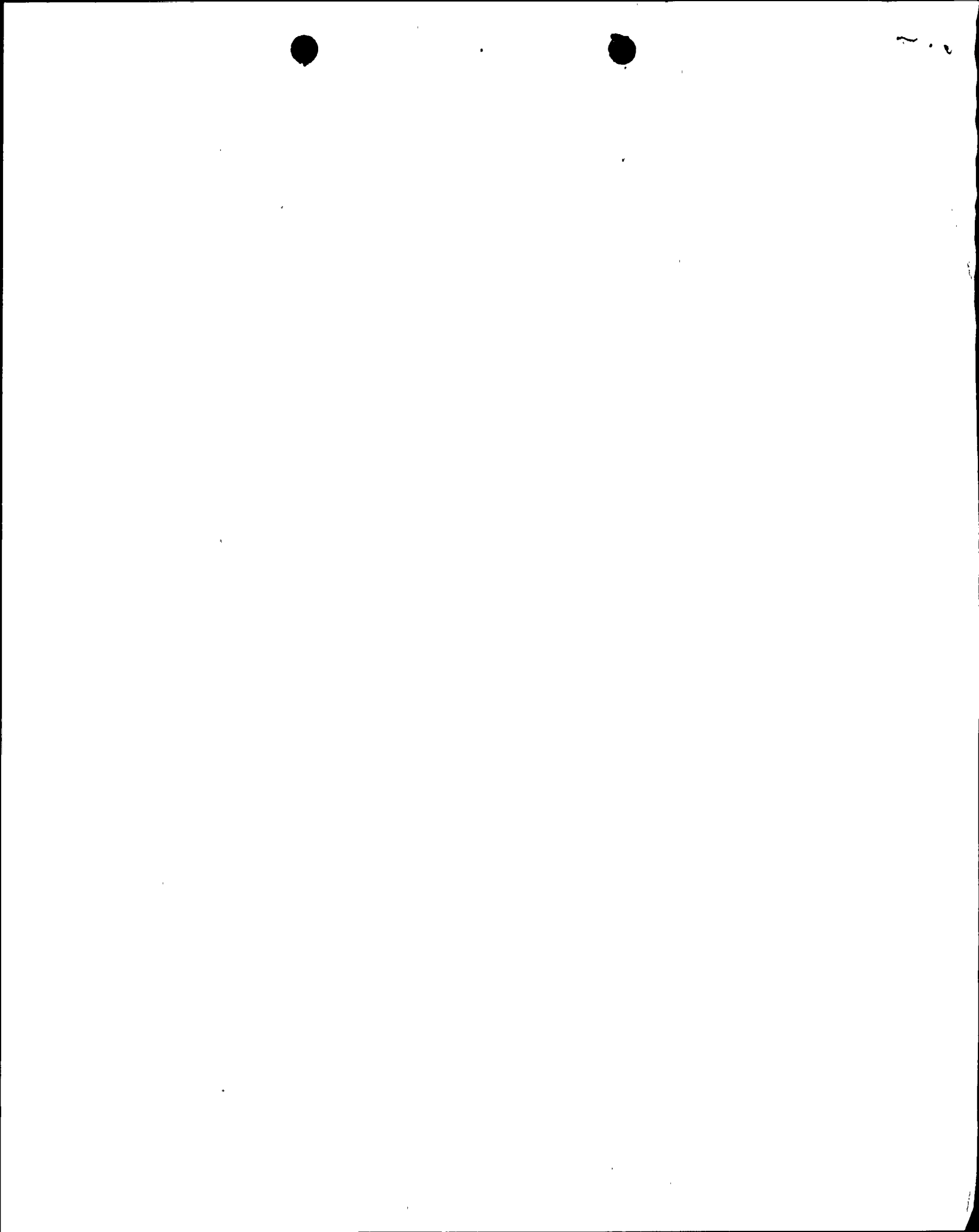

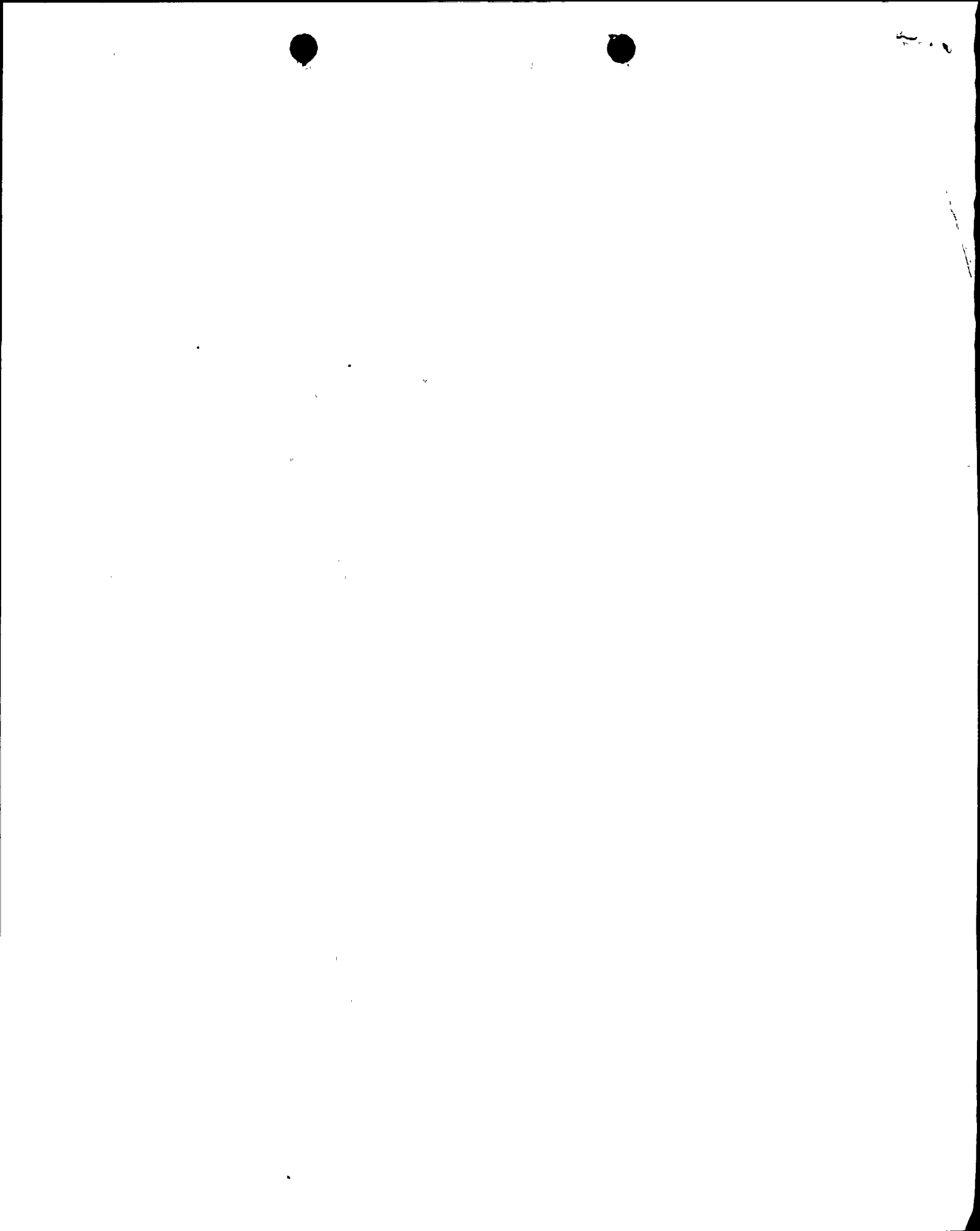


