This email is a follow-up to the voice message I left earlier today.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is nearing completion of its review of the license renewal application (LRA) for the University of Missouri-Columbia Research Reactor (MURR), located at the University of Missouri-Columbia, in Columbia, Missouri. If approved, the renewed license would authorize the continued operation of the MURR for an additional 20 years. As part of our LRA review, the NRC staff will issue an Environmental Assessment (EA). The development of the EA includes an opportunity for a review of the draft EA by the facility's state, a copy of which is attached to this email. The EA finds that the proposed action (i.e., renewal of the operating license for 20 years) will not have a significant impact on the quality of the human environment.
