Mr. Lawyer,

We would like to have the flexibility to use any of our gauges on various projects when needed. We possess the following gauges:

11 CPN MC Series gauges
2 Troxler 4640 Thin-Lift gauges
2 Troxler 3430 gauges

The total number of gauges is fifteen (15).

Right now, we only utilize the NRC license in DC so on any given day the actual gauge use is 0 to 2 Troxler 3430 gauges (more often 0 than 1 or 2). On rare occasions we use a Troxler 4640 gauge if testing asphalt. We would like to have the ability to use one of the CPN MC Series gauges, but that may not happen.

I hope this information answers the questions. If not, please contact me.
