During its 638th meeting on November 3-5, 2016, the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (the Committee) completed its review of the extended flow window license amendment request for the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant (Monticello), as well as the associated draft safety evaluation prepared by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff.

The Committee provided its report on the Monticello license amendment request to Chairman Stephen G. Burns in a letter dated November 15, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML16312A407). The NRC staff agrees with the Committee's recommendation that the agency approve the proposed license amendment, subject to the limitations and conditions discussed in the staff's safety evaluation.
