Re: NRC Notification of Emergence from Bankruptcy – Coal-Mac, Inc. – License 47-25599-01

To whom it may concern:

Per our previous notice to NRC dated Jan. 12, 2016, Arch Coal Inc. and certain of its direct and indirect subsidiaries filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. This notice is to inform NRC that on October 5, 2016, the company consummated its plan of reorganization and emerged from Chapter 11. Pursuant to the Plan, the Company's emergence from Chapter 11 did not constitute a change in control.

During the Chapter 11 reorganizing process, and upon emergence (Coal-Mac, Inc.) has retained control of all sources assigned to Coal-Mac, Inc. and under License 47-25599-01. Since filing on Jan. 11, 2016 for reorganization the new RSO position is now Douglas L. Boyd from Charles R. Waine. There has been no change in operation since filing.
