This letter refers to the inspection conducted from November 7-9, 2016, at the Honeywell Metropolis Works facility located in Metropolis, Illinois. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized under the license were conducted safely and in accordance with U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requirements. The enclosed report presents the results of the inspection. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and other members of your staff.

Areas examined during the inspection included physical protection measures for special nuclear material and hazardous chemical material, and information protection for NRC safeguards information. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. There were no violations identified.
