


Dear Mr. Panetta.

We applaud your response to the secret meetings of NRC
Chairman Hendrie and Commissioner Kennedy with PG&E regarding
the licensing of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. We
read with satisfaction of your firm and prompt chastisement of
such inappropriate behavior of two members of our Nuclear
Regulatory Commission. We feel well represented by your expression of concern.

It is shockingly inappropriate for officials who will directly make the decision on licensing of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power
Plant to meet individually with representatives of the applicant,
without the presence of an intervenor's representative.

We believe that their conduct diminishes greatly the possibility of objectively considering licensing of nuclear power plants.

We support your actions and urge you to seek removal of these men from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.



Subject: Disqualification of NRC Commissioners

Dear Senator Cranston,

We are concerned about the recent actions of Chairman Hendrie and Commissioner Kennedy of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Their secret meetings with PG&E officials on October 19, 1979 without the presence of an intervenor's representative constitute improper conduct for men in their position and jeopardize the possibility of correct implementation of licensing procedures in the future.

We believe that their actions disqualify them from objective consideration of the licensing of Diablo Nuclear Power Plant.

We urge you to do what can be done to remove these men from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
