Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGandE) hereby submits the attached comments justifying the location of its Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) for Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) as a follow-up to the site visit by Messrs. Grimes, Pagano and Ramos on October 21, 1980.

PGandE is convinced that its EOF site is the best possible for the Diablo Canyon Power Plant. San Luis Obispo County Emergency Services Office strongly endorses PGandE's selection. The overriding advantages of the current EOF location are accessibility, proximity to offsite emergency organizations and resources, and enhanced habitability. This will facilitate analysis of potential radiological impacts and determination of appropriate protective actions to ensure the public health and safety and to allow for overall management of recovery efforts.

In conclusion, PGandE firmly believes that this EOF location will maximize protection for the public health and safety.
