

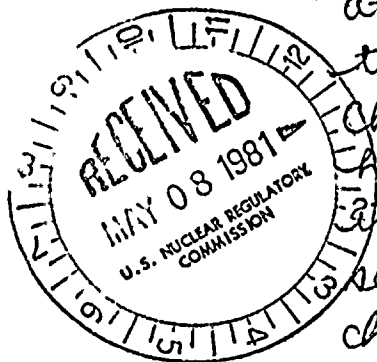

Dear Mr. Hendrie,

I am writing you regarding the proposed licensing of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Reactor. I live in Santa Barbara, directly down wind from this reactor. I am concerned about our safety should this reactor sustain a dysfunction in operation. Considering Diablo Canyon's proximity to the Hosgri earthquake fault, the expeditious manner in which the plant was built, the fact that there is no emergency evacuation plan for this area, and issues such as waste storage, decommission and plant security, it is imperative that public input into these issues prevail.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission reportedly represents the public, however in practice it is a self regulatory, self-serving commission that more accurately supports corporate investments, destined to plunder our environment for monetary interests. My right to a safe environment is not being protected by the NRC. People are dying from this source of energy at Three Mile Island, in Utah, and other places throughout this country and the world. As a Christian, I am deeply concerned with the human condition. As an individual, I am in my early 30's and have just begun to settle into my adult life. I plan to raise 5/10 children. Nuclear power poses an enormous threat to our survival and the very



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future of our planet.

at this time, the burden is being placed on the public to monetarily support the building, operating, decommissioning, and clean-up of plant accidents. Issuance of a low power testing license for Diablo Canyon is a back door entrance on behalf of the NRC to eventually achieve full operation of that plant. As a consumer, I refuse to pay for dangerous energy. As a ~~consumer~~ citizen, I refuse to live in danger.

Please bear my concerns in mind at the forthcoming hearings.
