

I am pleased to hear of more emphasis being placed on the licensing of new Nuclear Power Plants. Being a resident of Norristown, Penna., just 10 miles from Limerick and the plant now under construction, I am quite aware of the need for this and other nuclear facilities.

An area of concern is also about plants in Diablo Canyon and San Onofre, California, and being a frequent visitor to that area, my hope is that they may be activated as quickly as possible. The problems of safety and waste disposal do not concern me. The care taken so far, and the continuing research in both areas could not be handled in a more satisfactory manner, nor by more intelligent men and women. Would that other areas and problems in our lives be so well handled!

At this particular time, I urgently request that the plants in California be licensed without delay. That action could certainly help when Limerick and other plants under construction reach the critical point of licensing.
