In response to the Appeal Board's Order dated April 15, 1981, regarding USGS Open File Report 81-365, the Joint Intervenors filed a motion requesting the Appeal Board to reopen the record for the limited purpose of admitting the report and to establish a schedule for the parties to supplement their proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. The Joint Intervenors requested, in the alternative, that the Appeal Board reopen the hearing to take the testimony of the authors of USGS Open File Report 81-365.

Both the NRC staff and the Pacific Gas & Electric Gas Co.

("Applicant") responded with scientific affidavits attacking the

Open File Report. Both have requested this Board to take these
affidavits into the record should it decide to receive the Open

File Report into evidence. In contrast the Joint Intervenors interpreted the Appeal Board Order as a request for pleadings directed to procedural matters raised by receipt of the Open File Report

-- i.e., how should the Board proceed on this new information.

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
