I demand that Diablo Canyon not be put into operation. Diablo is too close to a fault line, an accident too possible (TMI), and waste not accounted for. **NO** to

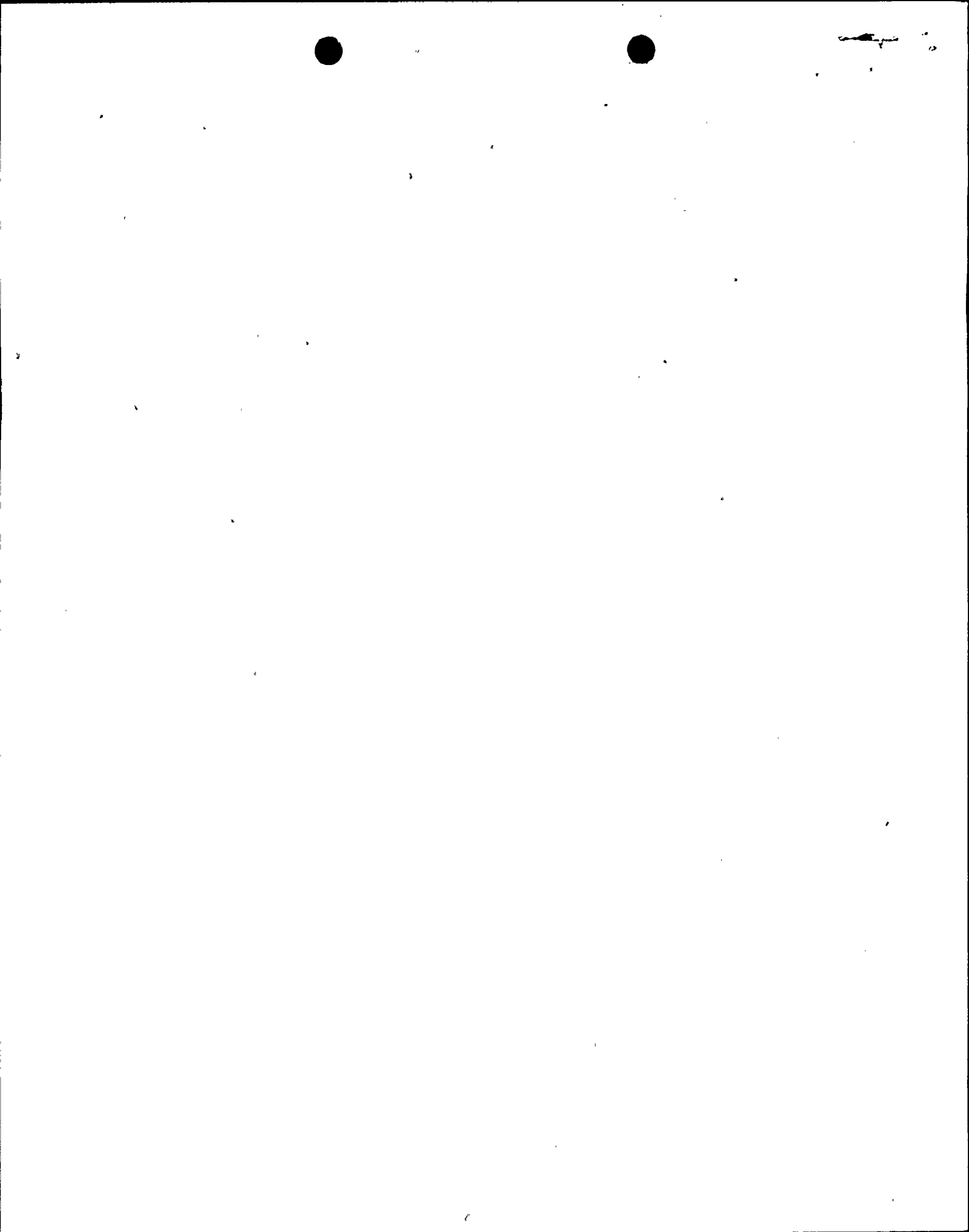
Diablo. I demand a response to this letter.
