SUBJECT: ALLEGATIONS CONCERNING THE DIABLO CANYON NUCLEAR POWER PLANT
(Board Notification No. 82-62)

In accordance with present NRC procedures for Board Notifications, the enclosed anonymous letter from a concerned engineer is provided to the Commission for information (Enclosure 1). The allegations expressed in the letter raise serious questions as to the design adequacy of Diablo Canyon, Unit 1. The allegations are related to the ongoing Independent Design Verification Program which is the subject, in part, of Commission Order CLI 81-30. The Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation requested the Office of Investigations and the Office of Inspection and Enforcement to review the letter for any action which they deemed appropriate. We have been advised by IE and OI that no investigation is warranted because they are satisfied that the concern identified in the letter will be covered by Phase II of the Independent Design Verification Program (see Enclosure 2). The material does not pertain to those matters that were resolved by ALAB 644.
