
PGandE's letters dated May 31, 1983, January 19, 1984 (DCL-84-017) and April 30, 1984 (DCL-84-165) provided schedules for resolution of TMI Action Item II.K.3.5, "Automatic Trip of Reactor Coolant Pumps" (RCPs), as requested by Generic Letter 83-10c. PGandE has been working with the Westinghouse Owners' Group (WOG) to address the two items of the generic letter requirements: 1) setpoints for RCP trip, and 2) guidance for justification of manual RCP trip.

WOG has completed its work and published a report entitled "Justification of Manual RCP Trip for Small Break LOCA Events," transmitted by Westinghouse letter WOG-84-143 dated March 9, 1984. PGandE has reviewed the report and has determined that the generic information presented provides the necessary justification that the manual RCP trip is acceptable for Diablo Canyon Units 1 and 2 when the RCP trip setpoints, consistent with Revision 1 to the WOG Emergency Response Guidelines, are in use.

PGandE's schedule for inclusion of the RCP trip setpoints in the Emergency Operating Procedures to complete item 1 is March 28, 1985, as described in PGandE's letter dated April 30, 1984 (DCL-84-165).
