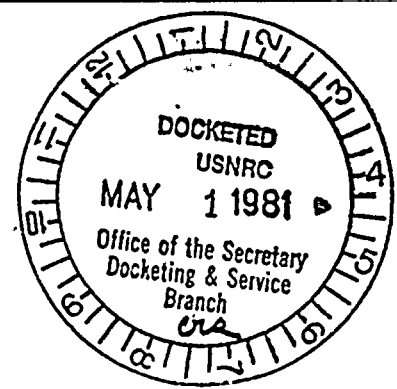

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Requiring Applicant to Answer Joint Intervenors'
Interrogatories 9 and 11)

The Board has received Joint Intervenors' Motion of March 31, 1981, to compel Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to answer their Interrogatories numbered 9 and 11. PG&E has not filed a response to that Motion.

PG&E has admitted in its answer to Interrogatory number one that the combined PG&E, State and local emergency response plans for Diablo Canyon do not comply at present with the Commission's revised emergency planning regulations (cf. 10 C.F.R. 50.47 and the guidance set forth in NUREG-0654).

The Board finds that parties to this proceeding are entitled to know what the admitted deficiencies are and which requirements, if any, will not be complied with before fuel loading.


