To license the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant at any level of power would be a grave error on the part of the NRC. 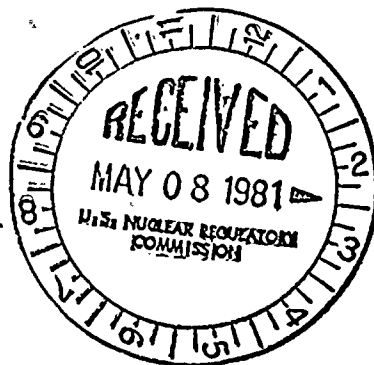
I would appreciate your prompt action on the

I am writing you to help speed up  
licensing of Diablo Canyon and San  
Onofre Nuclear Plants.

The 2,000 megawatt Diablo Canyon station  
at San Luis Obispo, which has been ready  
for 5 years, could cut California electric costs  
by an estimated \$80 million per month if licensed

per day, plus  $\frac{1}{2}$  million in interest charges.

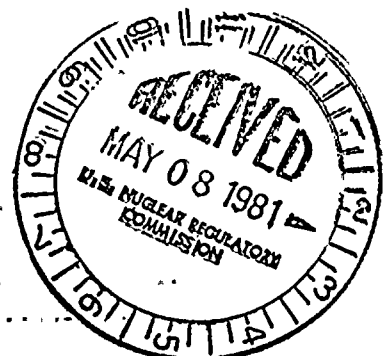

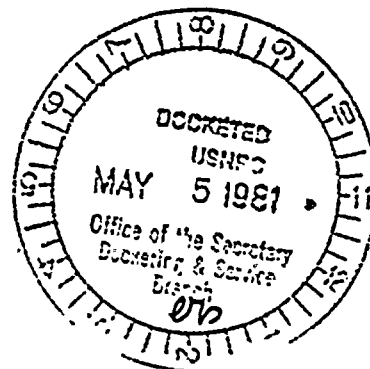
I would appreciate learning from you what the position of the NRC is with regard to the Bailly plant at this time, and what role the NRC may play in the future concerning whether it is constructed.

Dear Mr. Hendrie:

Those who debate nuclear power issues are frequently required to deal on very scientific and highly technical bases; however, with respect to Diablo Canyon power plant, Mother Nature lifts the burden of technical argumentation from the peoples' shoulders: discussion of licensing a nuclear power plant lying three miles from an earthquake fault is irresponsible, under any circumstances.

Furthermore, attempts to dismantle ill-conceived federal and state programs have, by and large, been unsuccessful: the costs of dismantling such projects are enormous and highly inaccessible. This waste of unreplenishable public funds should be stopped before Diablo Canyon power plant and its dangers become irreversible.

Among other issues, I implore you to address the problems of nuclear waste. And yet this request is obviously futile: experts and scientists inform us that no safe means of dispensing and storing nuclear waste exist.

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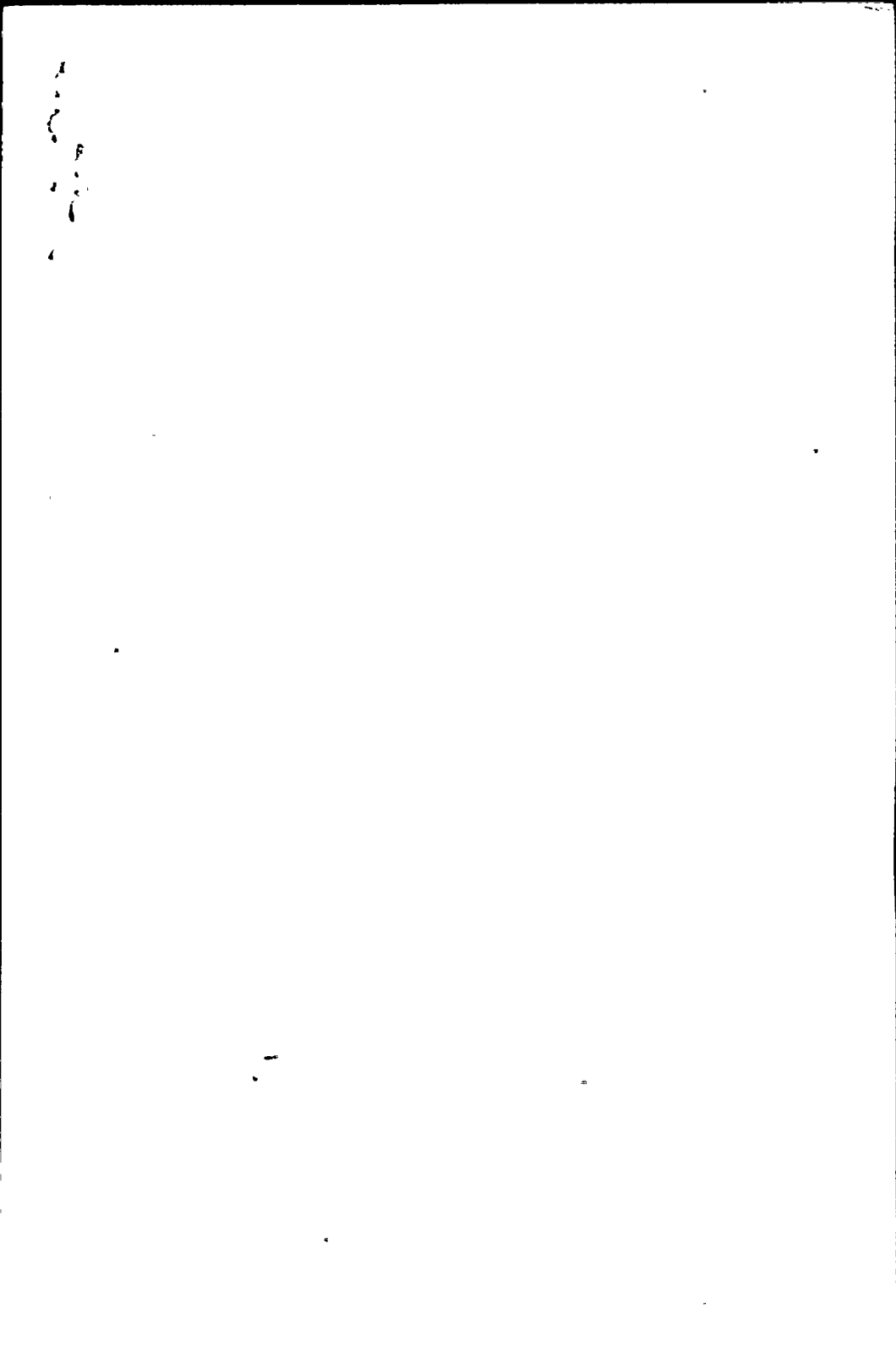

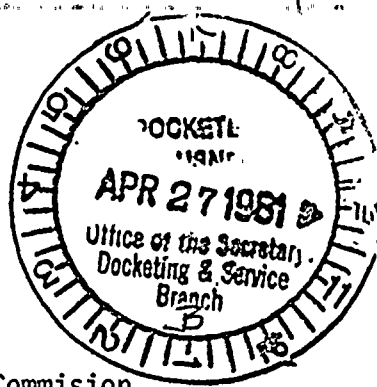

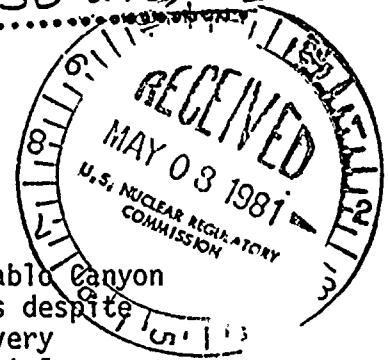

Dear Mr. Hendrie:

This letter is to urge you not to permit the licensing of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, in San Luis Obispo, California. I urge this despite the fact that I am a scientist, and a professor of science, and very receptive to modern technology. I urge this despite the fact that I am fully aware of our people's need for domestic energy sources.

My reasons for opposing Diablo include the usual ones: the Diablo plant is frighteningly near an unpredictable earthquake fault; emergency planning for San Luis is not sufficient; waste storage planning seems unfinished; human error is, in the long run, inevitable.

Two more reasons are important to me. First, San Luis is located in an extraordinarily blessed part of the earth. Because of its climate, terrain, and bioenvironment it is the most pleasant place for humans to live that I have ever seen--and I have seen much of the world. Such places are rare, and a great comfort to people who are privileged to visit them. The Diablo plant will cast a psychological pall over San Luis. The image that comes to mind is of Paradise relocated beneath the fires of Mordor. Production of nuclear power is necessarily anxiety-ridden: unceasing vigilance requires unceasing anxiety. To willfully impose anxiety on a place such as San Luis is to be stupidly profligate with our country's most precious psychological resources.

Second, I am ever mindful that no civilization, no matter what heights of technological greatness it has attained, has ever succeeded in maintaining that technology through the ages. I have lived in primitive villages in Afghanistan, in Turkey, in Peru, built on the ruins of civilizations that once were, in many ways, more sophisticated than ours is now. The people who live in those villages have lost their cultural legacy, through anti-intellectual revolution, through war, and famine, and epidemics, and economic collapse. No natural law of history says that knowledge lasts forever. America is not immune to history. In licensing nuclear power plants, you are supposing that our culture is immortal. The truth is that our culture may not last out the century, and we may leave our grandchildren a legacy of fire that they will not have the wit to control.

Again, I implore you: do not permit any licensing of Diablo:

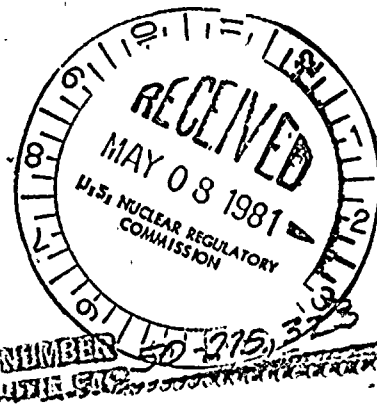
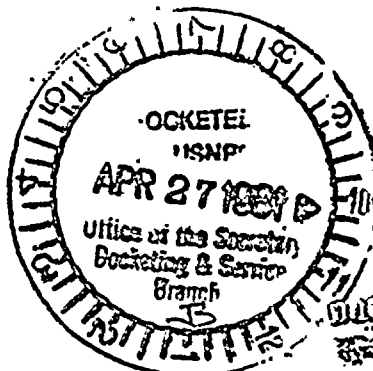

Dear Mr. Hendrie:

I wish to bring your attention to several facts that should be considered before any license is granted to Pacific Gas and Electric for the operation of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. I feel that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is placing its interest in profit and the perpetuation of centralized energy over the safety and health of the people of the Central Coast of California. The following four issues dramatically illustrate why this Nuclear Power Plant should not be permitted to operate.

The Hosgri Fault is less than three miles away from the plant. This active fault could deliver an earthquake ten times stronger than the plant is designed to withstand. The modifications done to the plant to deal with this problem are merely cosmetic and will not protect the facility from a major earthquake. Such an earthquake could possibly breach the integrity of the containment structure and lead to a melt-down condition and extensive radioactive leakage.


Another weak link at Diablo Canyon is the Plant Security. Although the security arrangements are adequate for dealing with peaceful demonstrators or lone lunatics, the Plant Security Forces could not protect the facility from a well planned terrorist commando attack. The Plant is accessible to attack from the rugged hills behind it and the ocean in front of it. A small force with few small arms could easily capture and damage this Power Plant. As worldwide terrorism becomes widespread this is a real threat.

And what of the deadly waste that this plant could ultimately produce? There is no safe way to transport or store the wastes from Nuclear Power Plants. Before any license can be granted to this or any other facility the problem of nuclear wastes must be solved. Any storage of nuclear waste on the premises of Diablo Canyon would increase the health risk to the citizens of this coastal area.

Finally, the long-term health effects of the low-level radioactive emissions from a nuclear power plant located so close to a populated area could be disastrous. These emissions will be incorporated into our soil, water and food supply in ever increasing concentrations near the plant. This area is an agricultural area and the contaminated food will not only be consumed locally, but will also be eaten by people who have no idea that their food was grown so close to a nuclear power plant.

I recognize the need for more and varied forms of energy production. But, in my job as an Air Quality Specialist, I have learned the quality of the environment and the health of the people must be placed before considerations of corporate profits, short term comforts, and the perpetuation of centralized energy production. Thank-you for this opportunity to bring these important issues to your attention. I enjoy living on the Central Coast of California and I would hate to be forced to move by an unhealthy environment.

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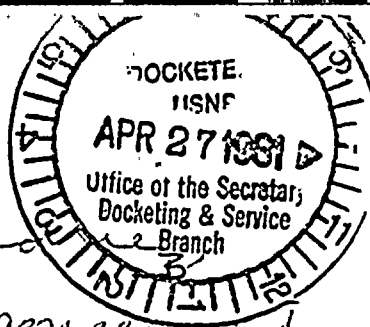

Tearings on Diablo Canyon are absolutely necessary. On July 9, 1979 EG&S announced 32 significant projects needed to prevent a XTVI-type accident and capable of being completed before nuclear operations begin-- plus seven more changes and 16 long range studies afterwards, many of them involving changes as significant as "plant modifications"

In addition, new safety problems have appeared and remain unanswered: earthquakes have been found to be able to release much greater forces than had been thought; we have had two quakes within a few miles of the Diablo Canyon plant as their epicenter; a fairly normal Pacific storm has destroyed a breakwater built to protect the plant's cooling water intake and EG&S now says it isn't needed and won't be rebuilt.

Also we don't have any emergency plan adequate for either the plant itself or the county. In fact, sensible evacuation is impossible here with winds always blowing south and the roads to the north dangerous without congestion, impassable when congested.

Unless all these problems can be solved, the plant will never be safe.

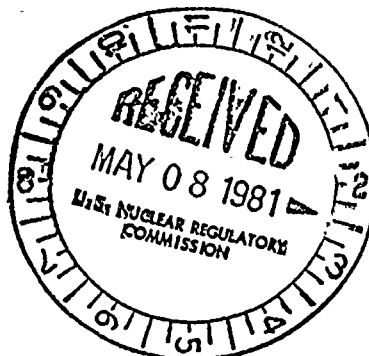
Most particularly, we are aware of the earthquake threat that is unique to this plant, and the absolute lack of emergency procedures for the surrounding area that might preserve our way of life.

As a stockholder in Pacific Gas and Electric Co., as the father of two children, and as a teacher of elementary school aged young people, I am writing to protest the recent company activated pressure to speed up the licensing of the proposed El Diablo Canyon Nuclear Energy plant.

Certainly you with your extensive scientific knowledge in the field of nuclear reactors and your close association with the near disaster at Three Mile Island must be fully aware of the need for taking every possible precaution before permitting the licensing of such a plant. There are just too many areas of question that have not been carefully explored and examined. Such potential problems as the plant's location less than three miles from a known earthquake fault, less-than-adequate emergency procedures, vague and questionable waste disposal provisions, etc., require thorough, disinterested, knowledgeable research which takes time and care. The current pressure for licensing seems to be entirely based on cost in dollars, without taking sufficient account of the potential cost in human lives. It seems consciousness to me to prohibit the people who live within 25 miles of the plant from participating in open hearings before licensing. Many of us, having watched the events at Three Mile Island two years ago with great anxiety and having learned with further anxiety the details of just what went wrong there, many of us in this area are deeply concerned.

I am asking that you share our concern and NOT respond to pressure for premature licensing. Even though I own stock in PG & E, I would far rather forego any hope of dividends in the future and as a ratepayer, cheerfully accept whatever higher cost of electricity might be necessary than I would risk in any way the radioactive contamination of this or any area.

The licensing of the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant would impose an unacceptable risk upon the people of California and especially upon the residents of the San Luis Obispo area. No structural changes in the plant can guarantee complete safety from the strong earthquakes possible from the nearby Hosgri fault. Please consider that an earthquake would not have to demolish the containment building to cause a serious accident; it would only have to cause one valve or one instrument to malfunction, as happened at Three Mile Island.

Other unresolved dangers include inadequate emergency plans, plant security, lack of waste disposal facilities, and routine low-level radioactive emissions.

In addition, nuclear power is not cost-effective, especially if costs of waste disposal and eventual decommissioning are included in calculations. California has many cheaper and safer options available in conservation and alternative energy. Diablo Canyon should be converted to the use of fossil fuel, of which we appear to have a surplus at present.

I am writing to express my recommendation for a reasoned and deliberate hearing into the licensure of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. I do not believe it is wise to fast-track the licensure of this plant; or to permit low level "testing" without first resolving several major issues. Public input must be solicited prior to the granting of any testing that would contaminate the plant with radioactivity.

I am a family man residing in San Luis Obispo County. My wife and I are expecting the birth of our baby in September. We are very concerned about what kind of life we will have in this county and what kinds of risks Diablo Canyon asks us to assume.

It is well known that the plant is sited within three miles off the Hosgri Fault and that there is great question as to the plant's capacity to withstand a major earthquake. Related to this is the inadequacy of emergency planning and evacuation route capacity for such an earthquake disaster. Plant security, in an era of international terrorism, is open doubt.

I also have major questions about the safety of long-term storage of nuclear wastes. We are asking future generations to assume the risk for our short-term desire to enjoy an energy "fix." Nuclear waste storage technology is far from expert; as we see at Hanford, Washington. I find it hard to ask those yet unborn to bear the burden of inadequate storage technology for periods up to ten to twenty times the length of current recorded human history. Decommissioning the plant itself will pose substantial clean-up issues, yet unsolved at the Humboldt Bay Plant. Finally, what do we really know about the progress of low-levels of radiation in our environment, in our food chain. This is cattle country and an agricultural region. We feed millions of people across California. Baseline studies need to be done before any nuclear operations proceed, for agricultural and public health purposes.

Again, I urge a careful, deliberate process in considering licensure of Diablo Canyon, along with public hearings. Alternate sources of energy and conservation can avoid expensive, risky nuclear plants, which require decommission in 30 years anyway.

The continued push by the Atomic Energy Consortium in this nation and the world to expand its foothold in the energy production needs of our society is most alarming and unnecessary.


Yea there is a need by our society for an oil free energy future, but this goal need not be attained by the use of a Highly poisonous and costly source such as nuclear energy.

Hearings on Diablo Canyon are absolutely necessary. On July 9, 1979 PG&E announced 32 significant projects needed to prevent a X-TMI-type accident and capable of being completed before nuclear operations begin-- plus seven more changes and 16 long range studies afterwards, many of them involving changes as significant as "plant modifications"

In addition, new safety problems have appeared and remain unanswered: earthquakes have been found to be able to release much greater forces than had been thought; we have had two quakes within a few miles of the Diablo Canyon plant as their epicenter; a fairly normal Pacific storm has destroyed a breakwater built to protect the plant's cooling water intake and PG&E now says it isn't needed and won't be rebuilt.

Also we don't have any emergency plan adequate for either the plant itself or the county. In fact, sensible evacuation is impossible here with winds always blowing south and the roads to the north dangerous without congestion, impassable when congested.

Unless all these problems can be solved, the plant will never be safe.

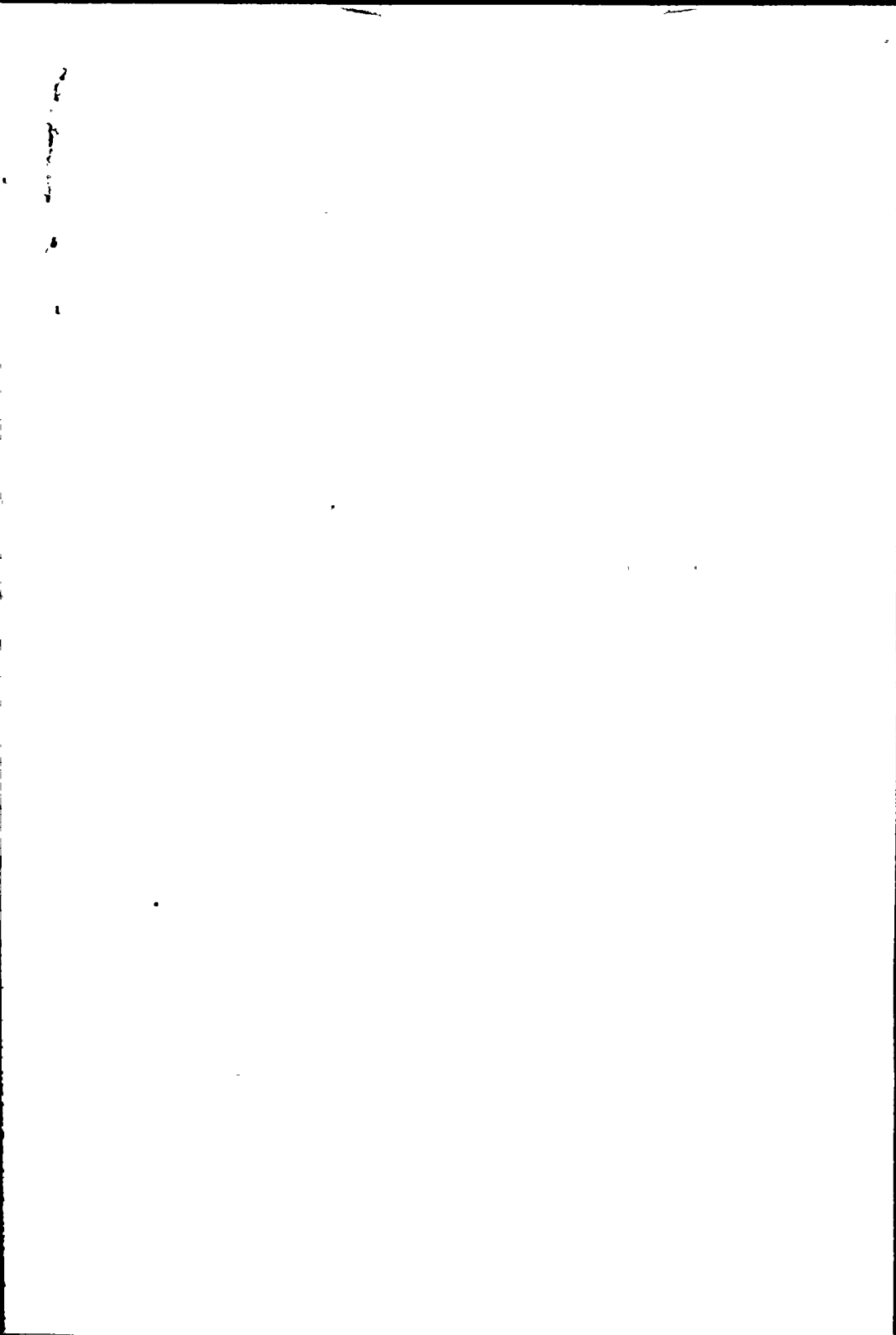

Diablo, as you know is a mere 2 1/2 miles away from the Hosgry fault. Why should ~~Diablo be exempt from the rules?~~ Furthermore, the plant is not even necessary. We get along quite nicely here with conservation on a personal level as well as in public buildings (Poly included).

I realize that P.G. & E. has spent a vast amount of money on building the reactor. Naturally they would like to see some profits from the plant. But did they ever consider how short a life the plant is likely to have - they really should, considering they are the owners of the now closed Humboldt Bay plant as well- and what it will cost them to decommission the plant? That is, not even to consider any mishap at the plant.

My heart goes out to all the mothers in the TMI region who lie awake nights wondering if their children will come down with leukemia.

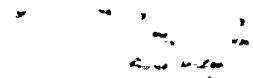

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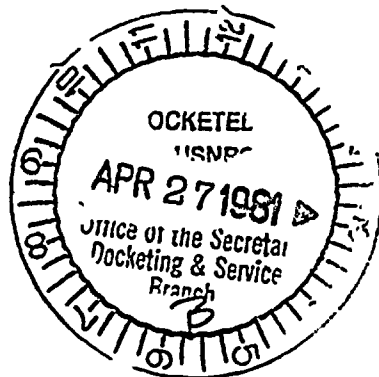

I am writing to ask your help to see that in the current press for more nuclear plants Diablo Canyon nuclear plant is not hastily licensed.

Until 1972 when we moved to Los Osos- six miles from Diablo Canyon- I was a staunch supporter of nuclear power. I am a college graduate and worked as a medical technician in medical research. Everything I had learned led me to believe that nuclear power was safe and clean.

However, in the eight years we have lived here I have learned of so many human errors in connection with the Diablo plant and so many suppressions and distortions of the truth by P G & E, the existence of the Hosgri fault for one, that I have changed my mind. I am now convinced that if Diablo goes into operation it will be only a question of time before a serious accident occurs. Accidents aren't the only worry however. I am just as concerned about the disposal of nuclear waste since there is as yet no safe method for this. The transportation of these wastes as well as the storage is another opportunity for an accident.

Nuclear mistakes are long-lasting, irreversible and sometimes slow to show themselves. An example is the medical use of X-rays to shrink thyroids and thymus glands thirty years ago. The treatment seemed harmless for twenty-five years until some of the patients so treated developed tumors at the site of radiation.

I cannot speak strongly enough against the licensing of this plant. The risks are far too great.

The same is true of Emergency Planning.

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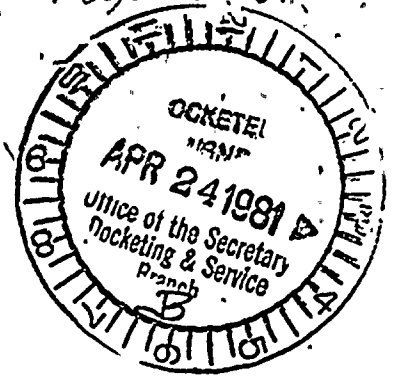

Thematically, my basic disagreement is ~~opposed~~ with nuclear power opposed to other forms of alternative energy.

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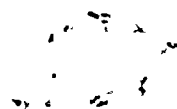

In response to a recent decision by the federal Nuclear Regulatory Commission that the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant will not be licensed to operate for at least another year, the Board of Directors of the Greater Bakersfield Chamber of Commerce (representing 1,000 member-firms and approximately 50,000 employees) believes it is imperative to express concern regarding this decision.

As you know, increasing our nation's energy independence is extremely important in order to provide: less dependence on foreign oil, a hedge against inflation, reliable energy-needs service and ultimately, lower power costs. As an example, researchers and statisticians have verified that if Diablo Canyon had been in full operation in 1979 and 1980 (as was originally scheduled), Californians would have saved more than one billion dollars, principally because all of the kilowatts supplied by oil during these years could have been provided by Diablo Canyon for a savings of 20 million barrels of oil annually.

We believe it is also important to note that the Diablo Canyon Plant is completely built and ready for operating, but it has been subjected to fourteen years of what is considered by experts to be the most rigorous design and safety reviews possible. As a result, it was expected that the low-power testing would have been conducted last fall (1980) and that the reactor would be generating full power before the end of 1981.

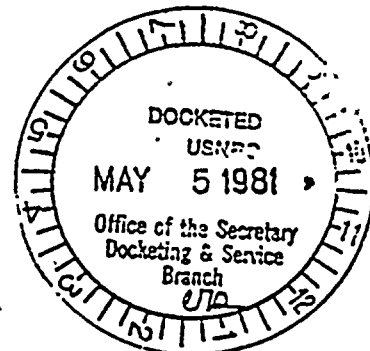

I am writing in regard to Pacific Gas & Electric's request for a low-power test license for the nuclear reactor at Diablo Canyon on the Central Coast of California; I understand this issue will be heard in San Luis Obispo fairly soon.

I am unalterably opposed to any kind of testing at the Diablo site, or at any site located anywhere near a major earthquake fault. In view of the fact that we do not yet know how to dispose safely of nuclear wastes, I'm not sure that I want to see nuclear reactors built anywhere at this time, but surely it is glaringly obvious that one has no business anywhere near a fault system. I do not know what you have been told about local evacuation plans and I do not know what fancies may exist on paper, but as a resident of this area I do know that there is no way out. If the Hosgri fault slips the city of San Luis Obispo just has no place to go.

There are other objections I could catalog, but the reactor's close proximity to the fault (2 1/2 miles) combined with the impossibility of protecting us here should be more than enough to influence the Commission's decision against PG&E. The term "low-power" isn't even slightly reassuring in this case: why test at low power something that can never be safely used at high power?

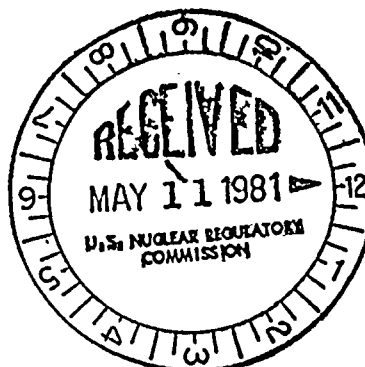

As a resident of San Luis Obispo, I'm writing to express concern over what appears to me to be a speed-up in the processing of Diablo Canyon's licensing procedure.

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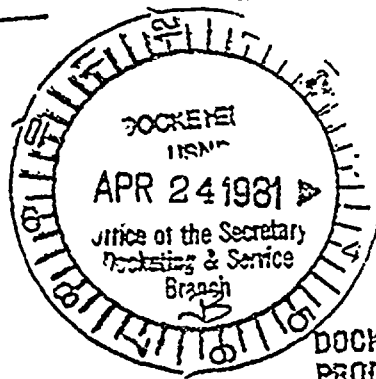

I am a resident of San Luis Obispo County, and am writing to express my concern regarding the licensing of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. The recent push by pro-nuclear forces to speed up the licensing of this plant, and the fact that the NRC appears to be responding to this pressure/lobbying disturbs and concerns me.

I recently went on a fairly in-depth tour of the Diablo plant that lasted over four hours. I was impressed by the technology, the attempts at envisioning possible problems and building in safeguards to prevent them, and the rigorous training program for the plant operators. But I wasn't reassured. Consider what it is that they, P.G. & E. are trying to come and make safe - nuclear power. The issues that remain unresolved are too important to be pushed aside.

One of my primary concerns on the general issue of nuclear power is waste storage. To pretend that we have the answers to adequate and safe storage with its incredibly long life span is ridiculous,



It would be if it wasn't so frightening in its implications. And what are the long term environmental affects of burying this waste deep in the earth's solid mass, or dumping in the ocean in containers that cannot last more than a quarter, or sometimes even a tenth of the life span of the waste? We have no way of knowing the answers, and today we are all paying dearly for this some type of environmental disregard with our world depleted and polluted.

My specific concerns with the Diablo Plant are the dangers posed by the proximity of the Hargis Fault; inadequate emergency and evacuation planning, and low level emissions.

The Hargis Fault lies less than 3 miles from the Diablo plant. I know they have upgraded the exterior structure and also areas inside. But the basic design of the plant is such that an earthquake could jolt the machinery out of alignment making a shut down impossible under those conditions. Anyone who lives in this area, or most of the West Coast must consider the threat of an earthquake as a very real and possible, even probable, danger.

The area affected/directly surrounding the Diablo plant has only 2 routes of access and/or evacuation; Highway 101 (1) going north or south. The only action local residents could take to

21



protect themselves under the worst rapidly developing accident conditions is to stay indoors and close the windows. I don't consider that an effective emergency plan.

My last concern is another long-term issue. What are the long term health effects of the NRC allowed low-level radioactive emissions from operating plants? The material is recycled through our soil and water, therefore our food supply, too. How will this affect my children and other generations? We learned too late about pesticides and other harmful build-ups that increase in concentration as time goes on. We do know that damage done to one area of the environment or food chain will sooner or later affect the rest of the whole.

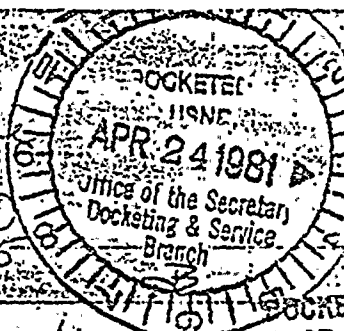
I feel very strongly the change we have to be stewards and caretakers of the earth. And I feel an urgent and direct responsibility to my children to safeguard their health and welfare. In carrying out these responsibilities, and if we all want to pass on the quality of life we value, these issues on nuclear power cannot be ignored, be passed and left unanswered in the haste to get Diablo licensed and on-line.

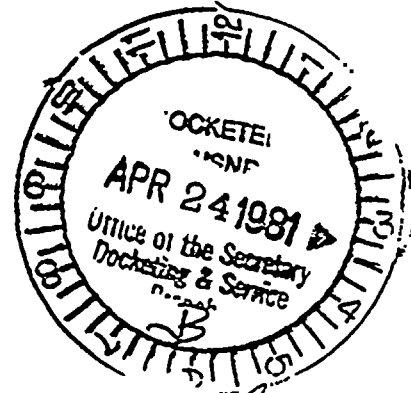

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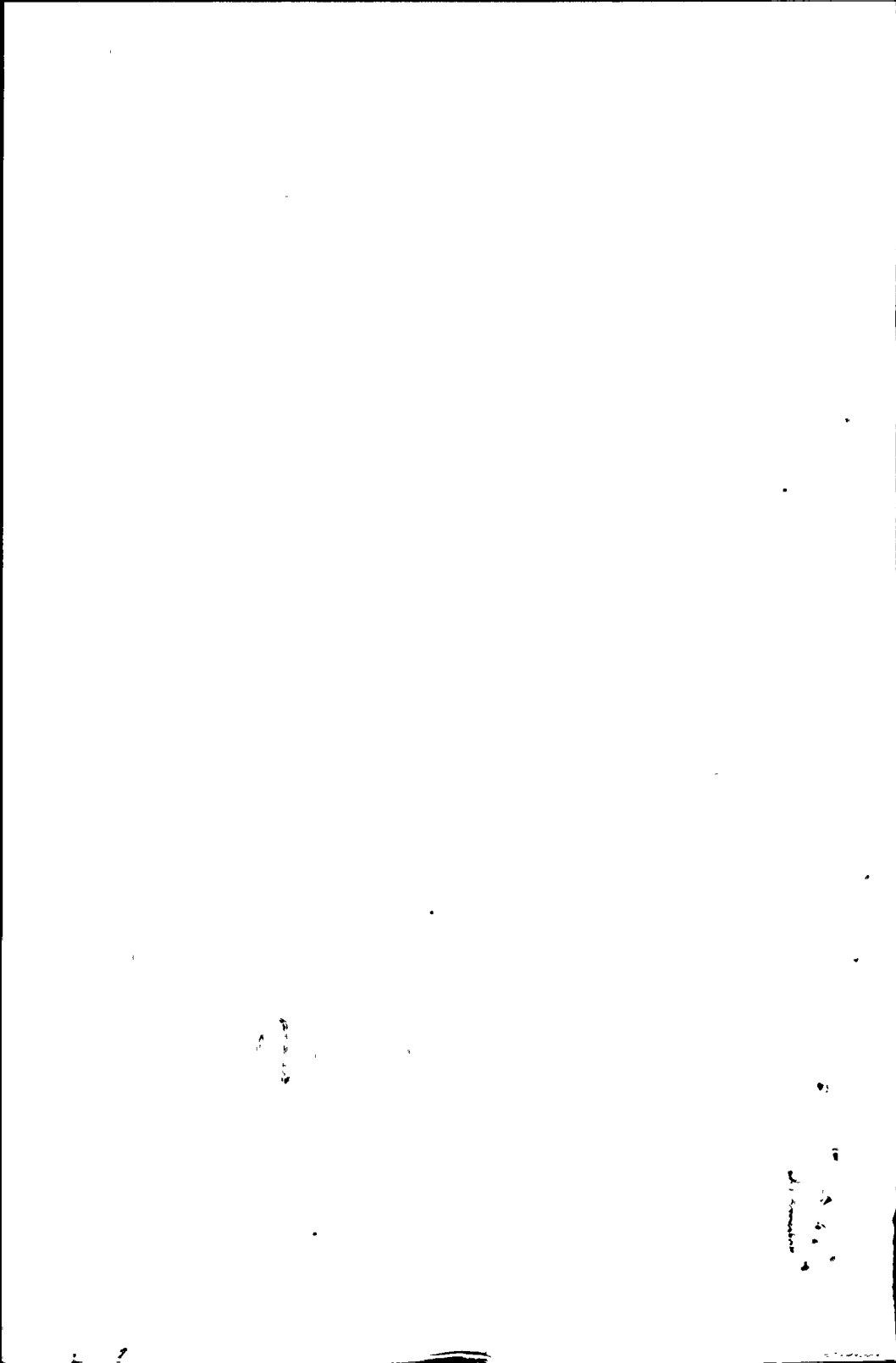
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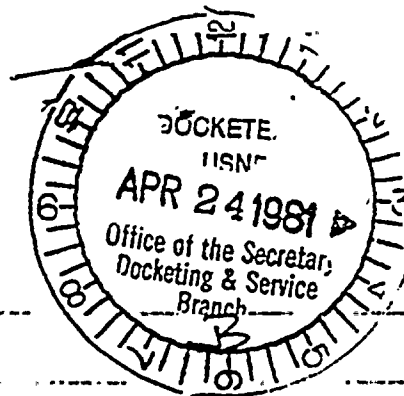

from toxic poisons and they will not be  
"white elephants" in future years.

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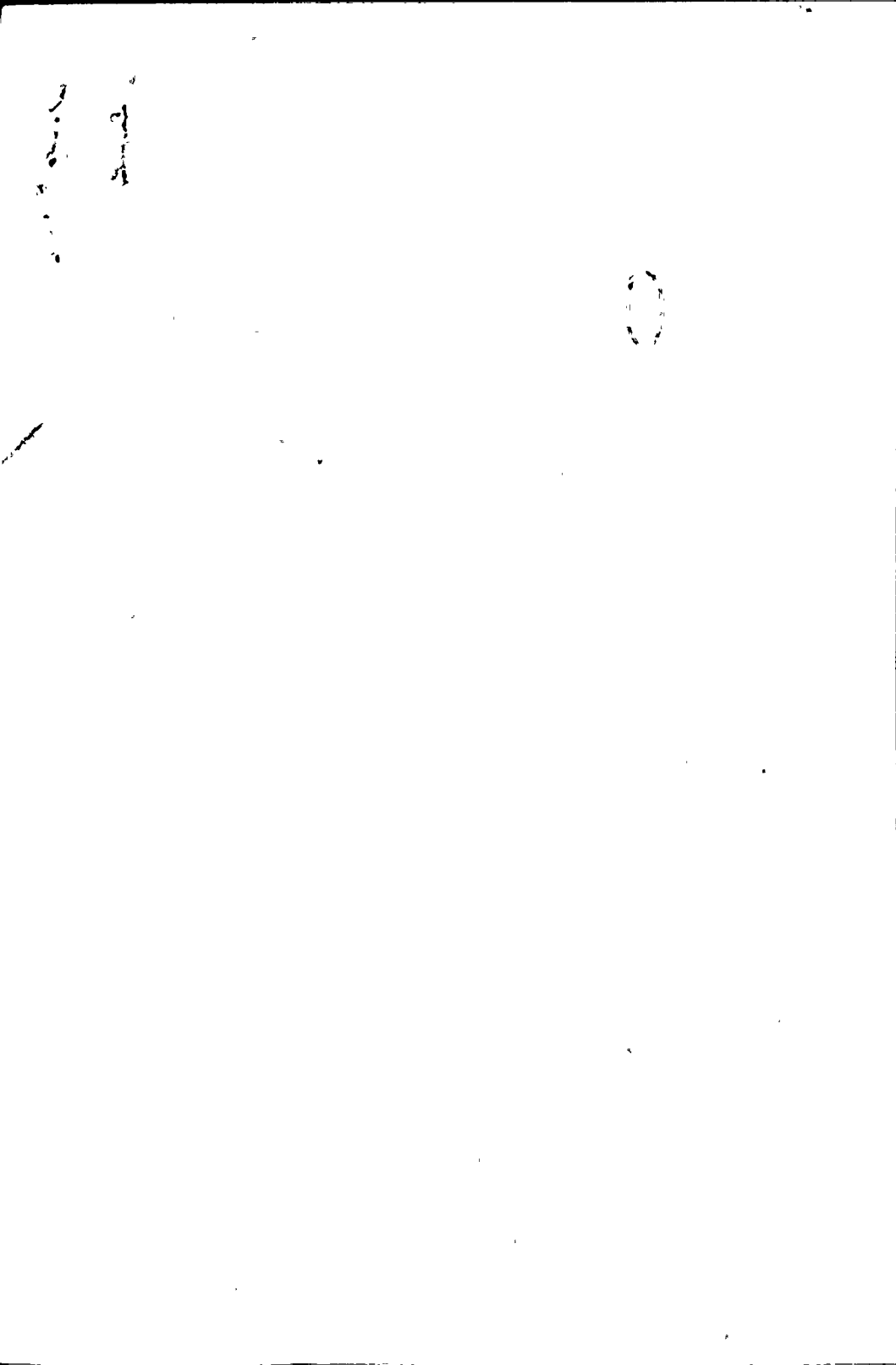
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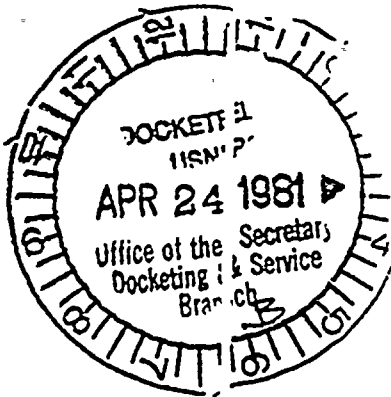

I am writing to express my concern about the licensing of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power plant.

As a local resident who lives only a few miles from the plant site I feel that there are some serious questions about this power plant that remain unresolved.

The fact that the Licensing Board may decide not to require public hearings before allowing Diablo to conduct low power testing causes me deep concern. It is vital that the public be heard on this issue.

The current emergency evacuation plan is a sham. The planners themselves admit that preparations are inadequate.

The question of what to do with the highly toxic radioactive waste has been given a quick once-over. No one seems to know how to safely dispose of the stuff - a development that by itself ought to give any intelligent person a reason to protest the further (over)

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proliferation of such material.

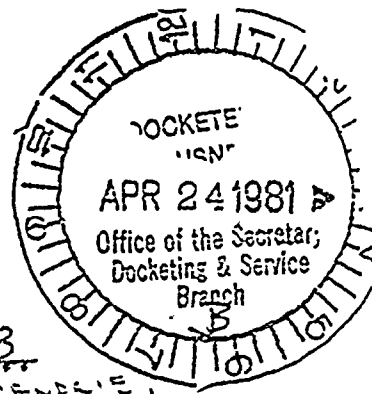

I live about 7 miles from the proposed Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power plant. I'm very concerned that the NRC may be trying to rush ahead with licensing of this plant without first resolving some very important issues.

The recent findings at the Imperial Valley earthquake may indicate that the Diablo Canyon Facility cannot withstand as strong (7.5 Richter) an earthquake as the nearby Hosgri Fault is capable of rendering. This issue must be cleared.

In the community I live in, there are only 2 roads leading in and out, both being closed yearly by flooding. If an accident at Diablo should occur during a large storm, I would be stranded. Even if the roads were open and clear, it would be near impossible to evacuate some 10,000 people in time to avoid

any radiation hazard.

There are many other reasons I feel this plant should not be opened as a nuclear facility: inadequate plant security, danger of low-level emissions, and waste storage to name a few. Please consider carefully what you are asking me and the other residents of the area to live with before you make any licensing decision. Thank you

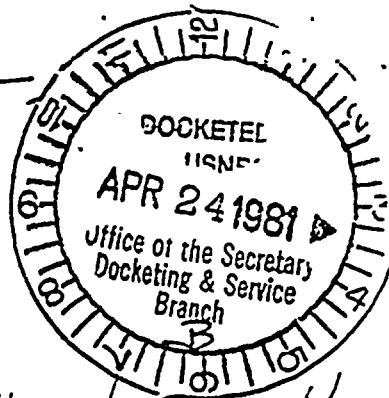

I am writing to express my concern about the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant in San Luis Obispo, California. I live just seven miles from the plant in the community of Los Osos, Calif., and the people in our area will be deeply affected by the plant if it goes on line.

As a minimum, I urge the NRC to hold local hearings (in San Luis Obispo) before any decision is made regarding the licensing of the plant (for either low-power testing or full-power operation). The public

must be able to provide input —  
we are the ones who must live with  
the plant!

As you know, Diablo Canyon is  
unique in many ways. With the  
Hogrei Fault lying less than three  
miles away from the plant, earth-  
quake safety becomes a prime  
consideration. Also, emergency  
planning for San Luis Obispo  
County is woefully inadequate —  
we have no evacuation plan in  
the event of an emergency. These  
issues must be resolved before  
the plant operates — even for low-  
power testing!

Other pressing issues demand to  
be resolved including plant  
security, waste storage, (are we  
to expect on-site storage?) decom-  
missioning, and the long-term  
effects of low-level radioactive  
emissions from the plant.

Before these issues are resolved,  
you should not even begin to  
consider licensing the plant!  
I do not feel that the people  
of this County should be made  
into human laboratories to  
test the unanswered questions  
of nuclear power!

It is up to you and the NRC  
to protect us from the safety  
hazards at Diablo Canyon. The  
plant should never have been  
built so close to an earthquake  
fault. It is the very least  
you can do to resolve the  
safety questions pending before  
you consider licensing the plant.

I hope you will consider  
the people of San Luis Obispo  
County and the risks we are  
taking before you make a



final decision on Diablo.
