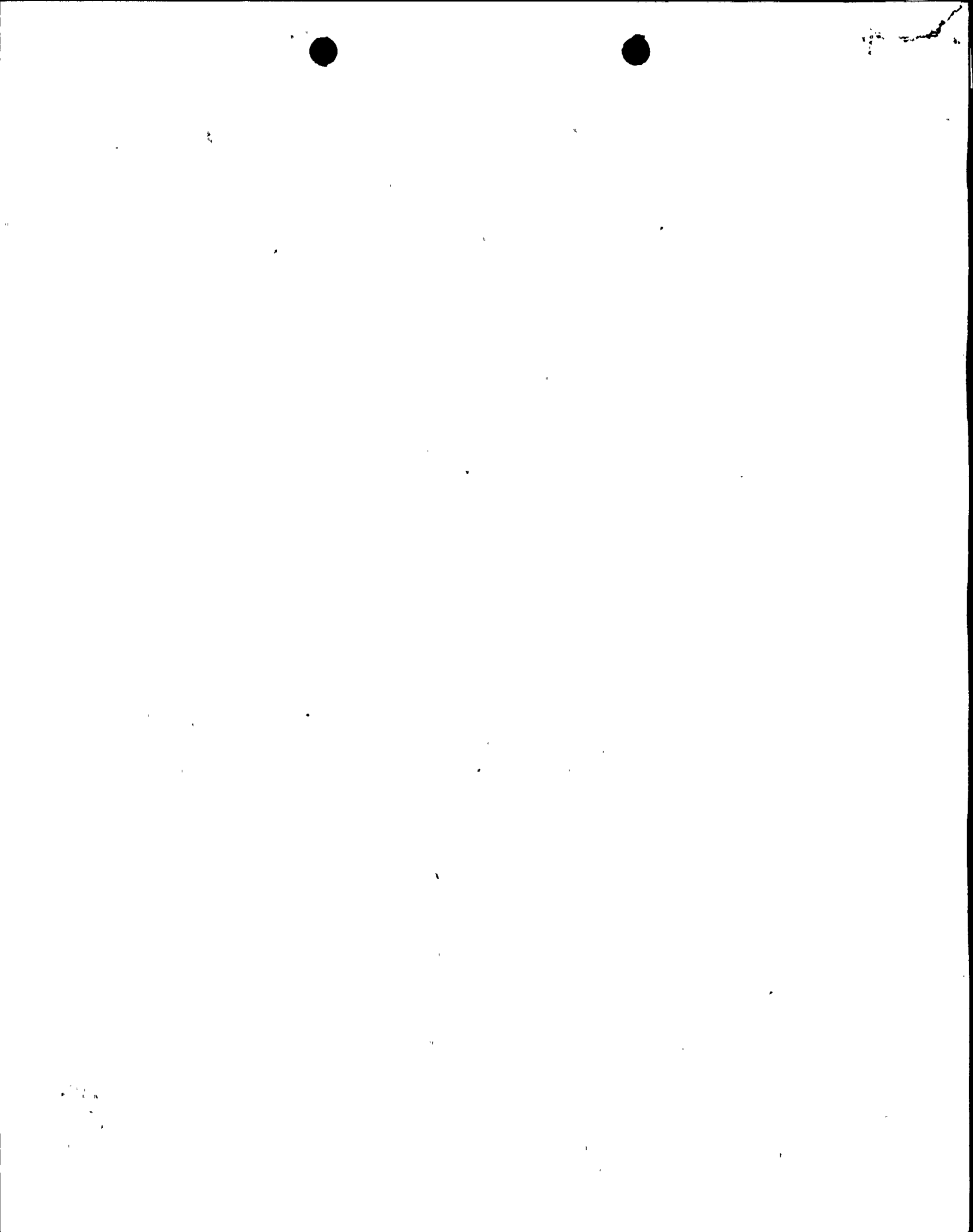

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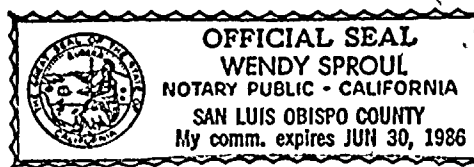


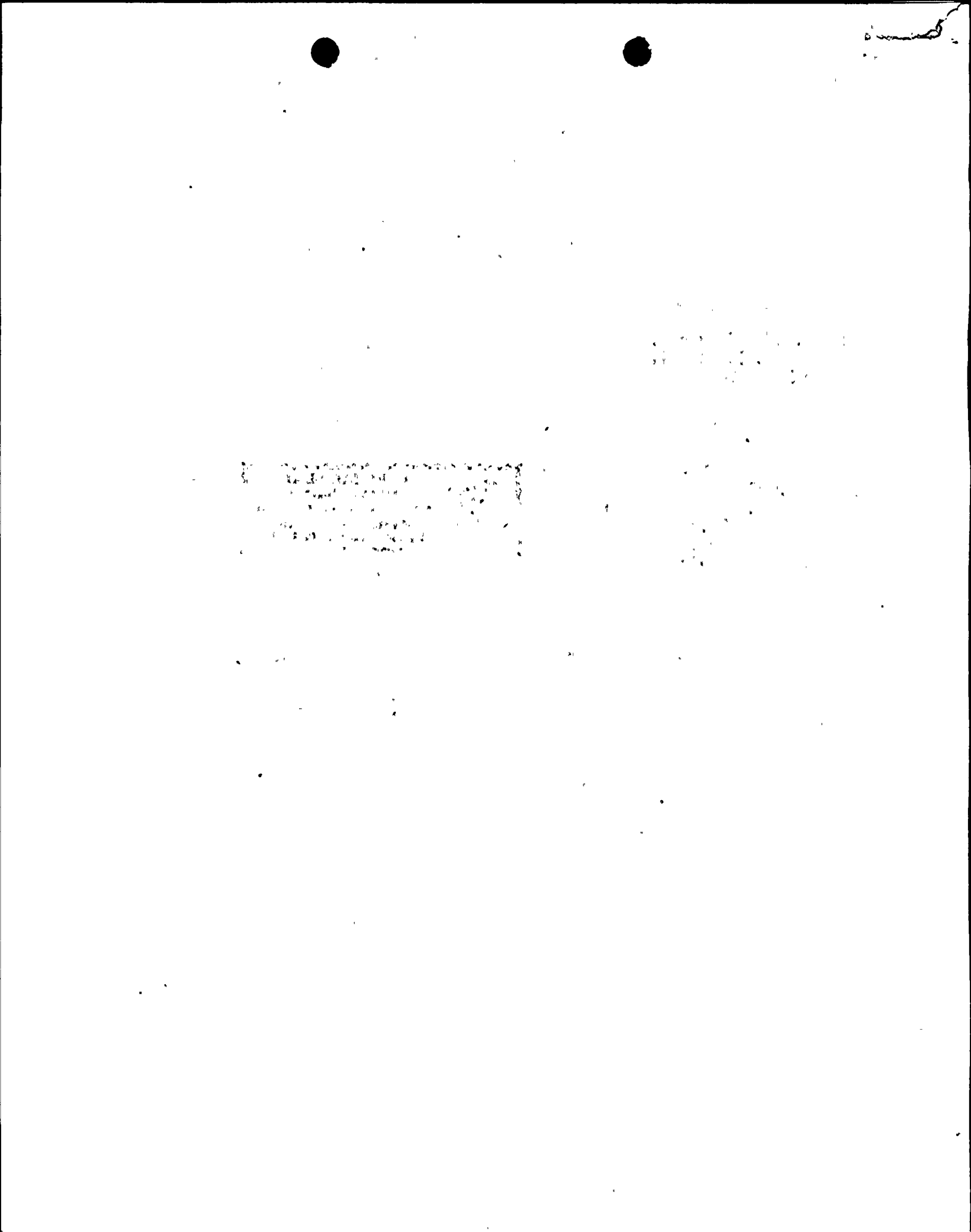

The White House has referred your Mailgram to President Reagan to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for reply.

The differences of professional opinion between Mr. Yin and other members of the NRC's technical staff have been known for some time and were, in fact, reported in some news media as early as late December of last year or early January of this year. These differences were not completely resolved when the Commission met on March 26 and 27 to discuss low power testing of Diablo Canyon 1.

As you probably know by now, Mr. Yin has, in the interim, agreed that low power testing could proceed while his remaining concerns over small and large-bore piping in Diablo Canyon 1 are resolved. He made his present views known at a meeting of the Commission's independent Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards on April 6 and the Committee later agreed to advise the Commission of its view that low power testing could proceed while those issues are being resolved.

As the present time, the Commission is scheduled to resume its discussion-- and possibly vote on--of the low power testing issue on Friday, April 13.

THE FLOW OF EVENTS REGARDING THE DIABLO CANYON NUCLEAR POWER PLANT AT THE BEGINNING OF THIS WEEK SERVE TO ILLUSTRATE DRAMATICALLY THAT, AS PRESENTLY CONSTITUTED, THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSIONERS AND THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF FORM A TRAVESTY OF A REGULATORY BODY. AS A TECHNICAL ENGINEER I CAN UNDERSTAND THAT THERE MAY BE DIFFERENCES OF OPINION REGARDING TECHNICAL MATTERS, HOWEVER, WHAT I DO NOT UNDERSTAND IS HOW A SUPPOSEDLY BONIFIED CONCERN OF MR ISA YIN COULD BE ALLEGEDLY IGNORED UNTIL THE OPENING OF THE HEARING TO GRANT THE LOW POWER LICENSE. NOT HAVING BEEN PRESENT, I HAVE ONLY THE PRESS REPORT TO GO ON. THE FOLLOWING ARE SOME QUESTIONS THAT MOST CERTAINLY NEED TO BE ANSWERED: 1. ALLEGEDLY MR YIN IS THE NRC'S EXPERT ON PIPING. IF SO, HOW COULD THE COMMISSION STAFF NOT READ HIS REPORT AS PRESS HAS INDICATED? 2. ASSUMING THE STAFF DID READ HIS REPORT AND DISAGREED WITH ITS CONCLUSION, WHY WAS THIS FACT NOT BROUGHT OUT IN THE HEARING? THE STAFF WAS ENTIRELY MUTE ON THE SUBJECT AND ACTED LIKE IT WAS A BIG SURPRISE. 3. HOW CAN IT BE POSSIBLE THAT MR YIN'S SUPERVISION WAS NOT AWARE OF HIS CONCERN PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE HEARING?

BASED ON WHAT I CAN READ FROM THE PRESS, THE NRC ACTION OR INACTION IN THIS MATTER BORDERED ON INCOMPETENCE AND SHOULD BE RECTIFIED AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE TIME.
