Dear Mr. Devine:

Enclosed is Board Notification 84-022 which provided in camera to the Commission and the Boards a transcript of a meeting held on January 25, 1984 by the NRC staff with Mr. Charles Stokes, at which you were present. The staff's determination for in camera notification was based on a request by Mr. Stokes and you, as expressed to Mr. Bishop of our Region V Office. Specifically, Mr. Stokes and you stated that during the meeting certain individuals were identified by name without their knowledge, and therefore, you requested that their identity not be disclosed.

We have enclosed two copies of the verbatim transcript of the meeting and request that you review the transcript and make editorial corrections as necessary. In addition, we request that you specifically identify the names and sections in the report which you consider necessary to be withheld from public disclosure, and your reasons for such withholding. We intend to issue the transcript, with the necessary deletions, to all parties and make it publicly available.

We request that you return a copy with the corrections and proposed deletions within one week after receipt of this letter.
