As chairman of the Santa Barbara County Chumash Indian Council I request that you hold on acting on PG and E's request (EPP) to you by Philip A. Crane on June 30, 1981 letter to you be made until our six local organizations can study and respond to the issue of our rights to hold religious ceremonies at SIO-2. We have hopes that we can work out a plan of responsible access to this area for religious worship that will be acceptable to PG and E. Many of us from the central coast are interested in having the right with proper supervision to worship at this location. We hope to convince the powers that be that we are responsible and will not be a cause for concern. In the past there has been much heartache over the moving of our people's resting places at Diablo and we appeal to you to help us in this matter.
