Walter,

You are correct. Only 27A/27B and 29 are the RCAs at Fort Riley.

License condition 11 refers to "Maps of the locations of the RCAs, "M101 Impact Areas," dated December 31, 2015 (but, sent February 12, 2016, (ML16048A358)." The map for Fort Riley in that document shows only 27A/27B and 29 and that map in that document is what counts.

Remember that I had some confusion over the RCAs at Fort Riley that we eventually cleared up. Apparently that confusion caused the NRC to mislabel 18 and 19 as RCAs in the SER. The NRC probably wrote that part of the SER before we cleared up the confusion and then missed making the correction later.

The license is what really matters, though, and it is correct. Thanks for noticing the mistake in the SER. I had missed it. I will let the NRC know about this, too, in case they want to modify the SER accordingly.
