Dear Mr. Denton:

Enclosed are three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of an application for amendment to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-80 and DPR-82.

This License Amendment Request proposes a one-time exemption to Units 1 and 2 Technical Specification 3.8.1.1 regarding the unit shutdown requirement for diesel generator inoperability. The one-time exemption would allow Diesel Generator 1-3, the swing diesel generator, to be inoperable for 10 days to perform preventive maintenance, inspection, and acceptance testing during the Unit 1 refueling outage without requiring both units to be in cold shutdown and without requiring the other operable diesels to be tested every 8 hours. The Unit 1 refueling outage is presently scheduled for September 1986.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 170.12(c), an application fee of \$150 is enclosed.

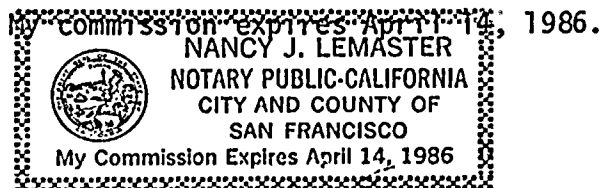
