Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated September 10, 1985 informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the items which we brought to your attention in our letter dated August 6, 1985. Your corrective actions will be verified during a future inspection.

With regard to the issue of chemistry and radiation protection technician qualifications we wish to point out that NRC considers chemistry as one speciality and radiation protection as another. We will examine your system designed to assure that only qualified technicians are assigned to fill responsible positions during future inspections. However, be aware that in those instances where performance deficiencies can be related to not meeting minimum qualification requirements, NRC enforcement action can result.
