Dear Commissioners and Staff:

On September 29, 1995, PG&E submitted for your information (PG&E letter DCL-95-217), a revision of the Bases for Technical Specification 3/4.7.1.2, "Auxiliary Feedwater System." The revision reduced the minimum auxiliary feedwater flow requirements. The changes also included expansion of the Bases consistent with NUREG-1431, "Standard Technical Specifications -Westinghouse Plants."

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.59, this Bases revision became effective on August 16, 1995, upon review and approval by the Plant Staff Review Committee and Plant Manager. The supporting documentation for this change included a Westinghouse proprietary report. The purpose of this letter is to transmit the associated proprietary transmittal documents that were not included with the original letter (DCL-95-217).

The enclosure contains the Proprietary Information from Public Disclosure, a Proprietary Information Notice, Copyright Notice, and an accompanying Affidavit CAW-96-1046 signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission, and it addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b) (4) of 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations. PG&E requests that the Westinghouse proprietary information be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790.






