This was a routine, unannounced inspection of a 100-bed hospital authorized for medical uses under 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300 in Greenfield, IN. The hospital employed 2 full-time nuclear medicine technologists who performed a full spectrum of studies. The technologists primarily utilized Tc-99m, occasionally utilized In-111, and administered Xe-133 about once a month. The technologists ordered unit doses from a local radiopharmacy, and approximately 35 diagnostic studies were conducted each week. The licensee had not performed any therapeutic administrations in the last 10 years. Additionally, the licensee employed an outside medical physicist who performed quarterly audits of the licensee's radiation safety program. Performance Observations: The inspector toured the nuclear medicine department and hot lab to evaluate the licensee's measures for materials security, hazard communication, and exposure control. The inspector conducted independent surveys of these areas, and found no exposures to members of the public distinguishable from background. The inspector observed the preparation and administration of a MUGA study. The inspector reviewed a selection of nuclear medicine records including dosimetry reports, audits, calibrations, hazmat training certificates, daily survey results, and radioactive waste disposal logs. No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
