This memorandum requests that the Commission provide the Executive Director for Operations (EDO) an explicit delegation of authority to initiate and sign two final rules. One rule would make a non-discretionary revision to NRC's maximum amount of primary nuclear liability insurance, and the other would amend particular regulatory provisions related to the Freedom of Information Act in accordance with the FOIA Improvement Act of 2016. Because both of these rulemakings are mandated by statute and do not present policy issues that require Commission resolution, I agree with the staff that it is appropriate to delegate authority to the EDO to initiate and sign these final rules.
