Subject: Registration of Use of Casks to Store Spent Fuel

In accordance with 10 CFR 72.212, "Conditions of general license issued under §72.210," paragraph (b)(2), Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) is registering, with the NRC, the use of two (2) casks under the general license to store spent fuel at Clinton Power Station, Unit 1 (CPS). The initial use of these casks to store spent fuel occurred on November 11, 2016. This registration is required to be submitted within 30 days of placement of the casks on the Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) Pad. Accordingly, this submittal is due by December 10, 2016.
