
Enclosed is a copy of the proposed revisions to Wisconsin Chapter DHS 157 'Radiation Protection'. The proposed rulemaking notice was published on Wisconsin's legislative website for a public comment period on December 19, 2016. We request NRC's comments by February 22, 2017.
