I am sending you this email in order to confirm the conversation we had last week (12/13/16) regarding EPA noticing NUREG-2176, Turkey Point COL FEIS, Supplement 1. Specifically, it was your opinion that the document did not rise to the level of a being a supplement because the information presented was not new and significant, and did not change the information in the FEIS filed with EPA on October 28, 2016. Additionally, we discussed the options if NRC preferred for EPA to file and publish notice of the document. We discussed whether it should be renamed as an "addendum" to the FEIS or changed to a draft supplement to the FEIS in order to allow for a public comment period. You noted that even if EPA does not file the document as a supplement, NRC is free to distribute the document and provide its own notice of the document's availability, if that is consistent with NRC's process. Please let me know if I did not characterize our conversation correctly.

Given EPA's perspective, especially our shared view that the information in the document did not result in changes to the analysis and conclusions in the FEIS, the NRC is thinking of preparing its own notice and distributing the document directly to the stakeholders, rather than filing the document with EPA.
