
In the NRC Form 314 "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated November 10, 2016, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys and based on its review, has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility located at 23801 West Warren Avenue, Dearborn Heights, Michigan is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-26391-01 is hereby terminated.
