Dear Mr. Shaw,

This is in reference to COL Huff's letter dated November 7, 2016, submitting financial assurance for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 19-08330-03, Docket No. 03006931. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. As stated in 10 CFR 30.35(e)(i), please provide:
 - a. The volume of onsite subsurface material containing residual radioactivity that will require remediation to meet the criteria for license termination
 - b. The means for adjusting cost estimates and associated funding levels periodically over the life of the facility; and
 - c. The identification of and justification for using the key assumptions contained in the decommissioning cost estimate.

These do not appear to be presented in the decommissioning funding plan.

2. The rate of \$30 per hour for an independent contractor to provide security appears low for your area. Please provide evidence that this is an accurate estimate of the rate.
