ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: This is on SECY-16-0143 – Florida Power & Light Co. (Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Units 6 and 7). The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order addressing the schedule for the mandatory hearing associated with the combined license application for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order that postpones the mandatory hearing until the NRC Staff has completed ongoing consultations required by the Endangered Species Act. The Commission directs the Staff to provide within ten days its best estimate of the time frame for concluding consultations and to supplement its testimony in this matter once consultations have concluded.
