SUBJECT: APPLICATIONS FOR NRC IMPORT (IW029/01) AND EXPORT (XW018/01)
LICENSE AMENDMENTS

Enclosed for your consideration are applications (Enclosures 1 and 2) to amend licenses IW029/01 and XW018/01 for the import and export of radioactive waste from/to Germany. The applications, dated October 21, 2016, and October 27, 2016, were received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) October 27, 2016, and October 31, 2016, from EnergySolutions Services, Inc. We are sending analogous letters to Ms. Linda Walters of the Southeast Interstate Compact on Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management, for her consideration.

If issued, the license amendment will:

- 1) Change the company name from Duratek to EnergySolutions Services, Inc.; and
- 2) Extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2016, to December 31, 2021.

Copies of the import and export applications were forwarded to the U.S. Department of State (DOS) on November 18, 2016, for assistance in notifying German Government authorities of the amended proposal to import radioactive waste into the United States. *Federal Register* Notices regarding these applications were published on January 5, 2017 (Enclosures 3 and 4).


