13. Each lot of timepieces, hands and dials received, containing tritium for distribution pursuant to 10 CFR 30.15, must be accompanied by a certificate which attests to the following:
 - A. The timepieces, hands, and dials have been manufactured in accordance with the International Atomic Energy Agency, International Standards Organization, OECD Nuclear Energy Agency, American National Standards Institute or equivalent industry standard; and
 - B. The amount of tritium on the timepieces, hands, and dials is not in excess of the maximum Permissible amount authorized in 10 CFR 30.15(a).
