**Staff Issued Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant Renewed Operating License**

By Commission approval in SRM-SECY-16-0138 (December 14, 2016), on December 15, 2016, the staff issued the renewed operating license for Fermi 2 Nuclear Power Plant authorizing operating for an additional 20 years beyond the original license expiration date. The new expiration date is March 20, 2045. The staff completed the review as documented in the Safety Evaluation Report, NUREG-2210, published in December 2016, and Supplement 56 to the Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants, NUREG-1437, published in September 2016. The issuance of the Fermi 2 renewed license brings the total number of renewals to 87 reactor units.
