

**PROGRAM SCOPE**

This was an unannounced, inspection of a 25-bed hospital that was authorized by the license to use any byproduct material as needed, for any study permitted by 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200 at the location specified on the license. The licensee requested to have their license terminated and all material and activities to be transferred to Nuclear Diagnosis, LLC. (24-17561-01) in letter dated September 28, 2016. This inspection was to confirm that all activity under the 24-32611-01 license had stopped and transferred to Nuclear Diagnosis, LLC. The license was officially terminated on December 22, 2016.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified during this inspection.
