NRC STAFF BEST ESTIMATE OF TIME FOR CONCLUDING CONSULTATIONS

Pursuant to the Commission Memorandum and Order in CLI-17-01 dated January 4, 2017,<sup>[1]</sup> the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“Staff”) hereby informs the Commission of the Staff’s best estimate for concluding consultation with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (“FWS”) and the National Marine Fisheries Service (“NMFS”) regarding the Florida Power and Light Company combined license application for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 (“Application”). The Staff estimates that consultation with FWS and NMFS under Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act consultation on the Application, including issuance of any biological opinions, will be completed on or about May 31, 2017 based on recent communications with FWS and NMFS. As directed by the Commission, the Staff will promptly notify the Commission once consultations are concluded, and will supplement its information paper within fourteen days after the conclusion of the consultations. The Staff will update the status of the consultations by April 14, 2017.
