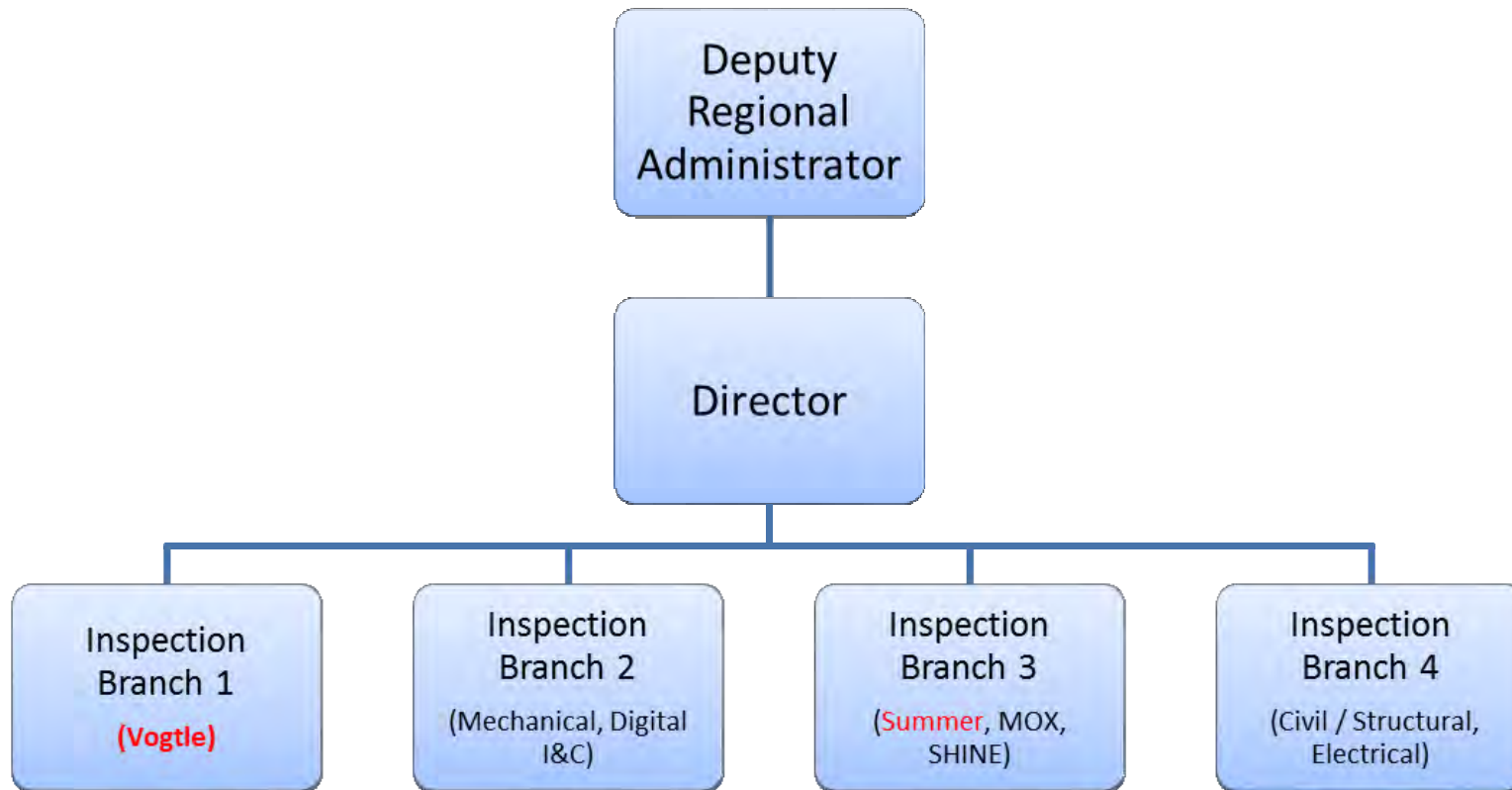

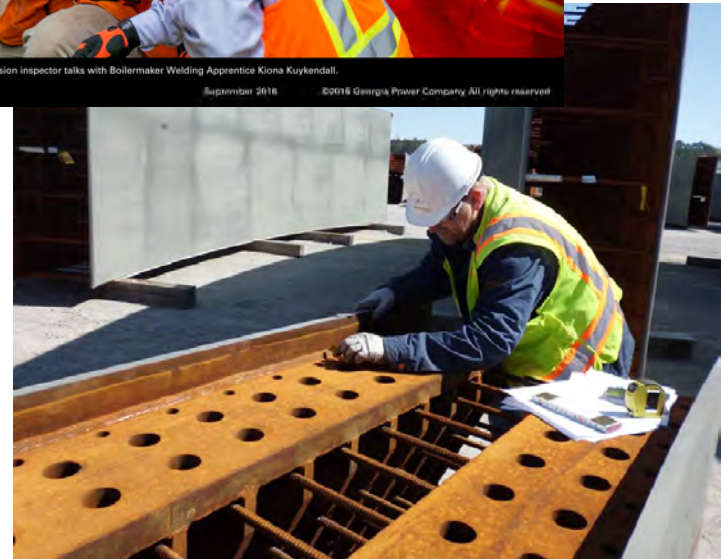

- Continuity, Perspective, and Awareness



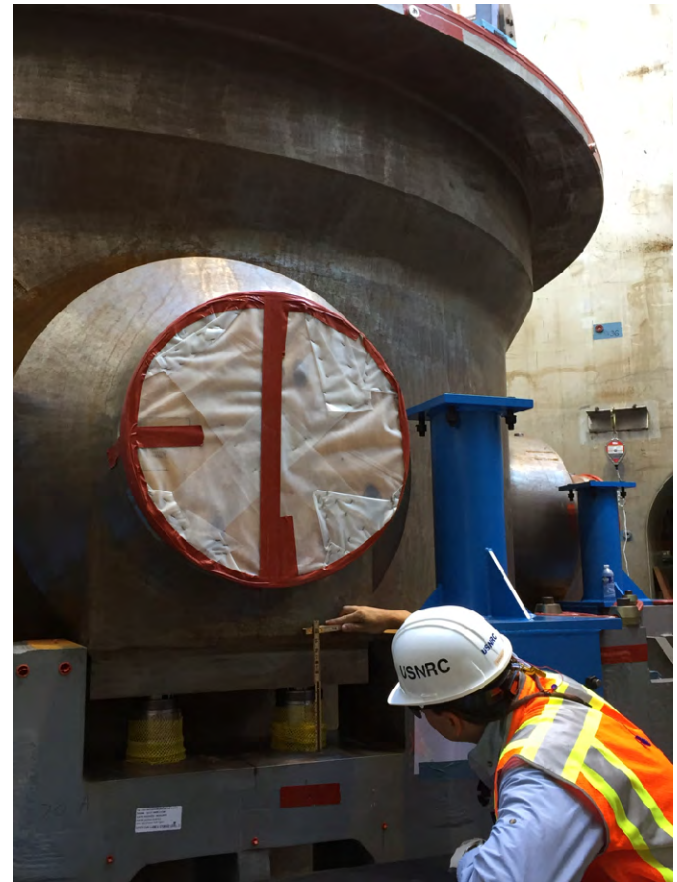
Lessons Learned

- ITAAC-Related Records

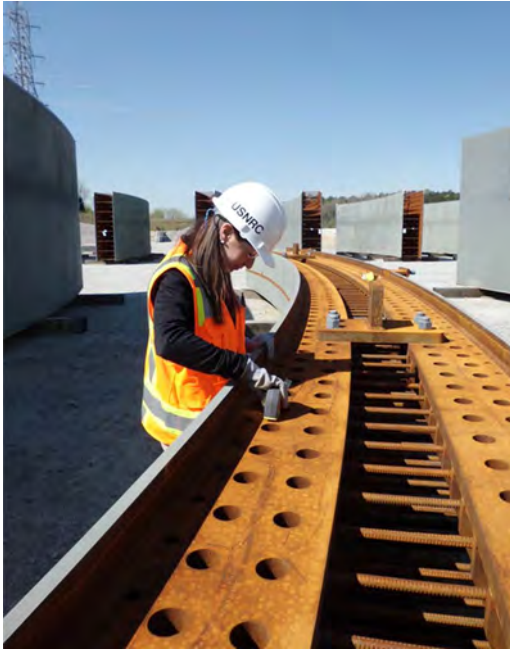


Upcoming Challenges
