SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF REVIEW OF 2016  
ANNUAL INSPECTION REPORT FOR URANIUM MILL TAILINGS RADIATION  
CONTROL ACT TITLE II SITES

Dear Mr. Bush:

I am writing in response to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) report entitled "2016 Annual Site Inspection and Monitoring Report for Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act Title II Sites" dated November 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML16327A459). The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed the report and has the following comment:

1. For the Maybell West, Colorado site, the report indicates that boundary markers BM-3 and BM-6 could not be located and that a follow up investigation would be conducted. Suggest that the results of the investigation, and any actions taken by the DOE to re-install boundary markers be included in the 2017 inspection report.
2. For the Sherwood, Washington, disposal site, in the NRC staff comments on the 2015 inspection report the NRC staff questioned whether the un-compacted cover continues to settle (ADAMS Accession Number 16013A301). In response, the DOE stated that a survey of the disposal cell cover would be conducted in 2016 and the results would be compared to the 1999 data to determine the amount of settlement (ADAMS Accession Number ML16083A221). The 2016 inspection report states that the survey was conducted and that the results of the evaluation will be provided to the NRC. We look forward to reviewing the survey report and closing this issue. Please provide the report to the NRC when it is available.
3. For the Edgemont site, the DOE plans to study the effects of the July 2016 wildfire on the vegetative cover of the cell and surrounding areas. Please provide the NRC staff with the results of the study when it is available.
