(Hawthorne Shipment) for NRC License 21-32838-01

Dear Administrator,

The US Army TACOM LCMC initiated a phone call and submitted a report on November 21, 2016 for an unaccounted for USMC shipment involving a multiple of tritium radioactive commodities falling under the Army NRC license 21-32838-01. The event number being assigned as 52387.

As of this date, the tritium radioactive commodities are still unaccounted for, however the USMC has indicated the USMC personnel are performing a wall to wall inventory of an Albany warehouse. The inventory could take up to four months, due to the size of the warehouse. The wall to wall effort was initiated due to complaints regarding good accountability practices at the warehouse. The unaccounted for radioactive commodities will be looked for in the process of the inventory.
