Dear Administrator:

Up-side Radiological Services, LLC (USRS) has concluded performing certain activities at the Naval Station Roosevelt Roads, in Cieba, Puerto Rico under the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Radioactive Materials License listed above. In accordance with license condition 18 B, USRS concluded activities under our license on December 14, 2016.

The activities USRS performed were limited to health physics support services during the survey of metal debris potentially containing Magnesium-thorium (MagThor). During the survey work, 4 pieces of metal debris were identified as containing radioactive materials and secured inside a B-25 Box. The B-25 Box was placed inside a Radioactive Materials Area (RMA) and secured. The Navy and a Department of Defense Executive Agency for the management of Low Level Radioactive Waste licensee is now in control of the secured B-25 Box.

The Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) responsible for notification to the NRC under license condition 18A was Mr. Brian Henderson. Mr. Henderson is no longer with USRS and Mr. Daryl DeLong has been formally named as the RSO.
