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Dear Mr. Didion,

This is in reference to your letter dated December 22, 2016, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-11451-01, Docket No. 03006692. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

You are requesting what appears to be a transfer of direct control. Full disclosure and approval of the NRC is required prior to transfer of control as stated in 10 CFR 30.34(b) (<https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/cfr/part030/part030-0034.html>). The request must also be publically posted for 30 days prior to transfer of control.

1. Please confirm if the new owner has purchased the facility, the date of the transfer, or the proposed date of the transfer.
2. Please provide the information requested in section 5 of NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses (<https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v15/>). Your response needs to be signed by a management representative from Essroc Cement Corporation as well as from Argos USA Corporation.
3. The NRC has implemented a new licensing protocol. Please state the amount of activity you wish to be licensed for each model of Thermo Fisher Scientific Cross Belt Analyzers on your license.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 592733. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you **within 14 calendar days** from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application OR amendment request.
