This request is to ensure that the documentation the licensee has on file is complete in regards to commitments required by the US Army TACOM LCMC to the NRC. The license was initially managed out of Rock Island Arsenal at Rock Island, IL, under Material License No. 12-00722-06. When the license management was transferred to TACOM LCMC located in Warren, MI, it is possible that some documents or parts of documents were not transferred. At the time of the transfer the current license number 21-32838-01 was issued and license 12-00722-06 was terminated.
