The Revision Log of the SQN Physical Security Plan, Training and Qualification Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation Security Program, provided in the enclosure, describes the recent change. The revised plan became effective as of November 23, 2016.

Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) has evaluated the changes contained in this revision and does not consider the revision to decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the subject plan.

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
