Enclosed is an application, dated January 18, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from Edlow International Company on behalf of PT Industri Nuklir Indonesia (PT INUKI), for amendment No. 01 to XSNM3768. The license presently authorizes the export of 40.50 kilograms (kg) of low-enriched uranium, in the form of broken metal to be used for medical isotope production at the GA Siwabessy Research Reactor, and target fabrication at the PT INUKI, located in Indonesia.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) increase the quantity of material being exported; 2) include an additional "Other U.S. Parties to the Export;" and 3) remove an "Ultimate Foreign Consignee(s)," and list it as an "Intermediate Foreign Consignee(s)."

Assurances from Indonesia that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that, if possible, the applicant has requested an expedited review of this application in order to maintain a first shipment date of May 2017.
