SUBJECT: DESIGNEES AUTHORIZED TO DISCLOSE CLASSIFIED
INFORMATION IN AN EMERGENCY

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 4.2(b) of Executive Order 13526, "Classified National Security Information," dated December 29, 2009, in emergency situations, in which there is an imminent threat to life or in defense of the homeland, an agency head or any designee may authorize the disclosure of classified information to an individual or individuals who are otherwise not eligible for access. Personnel that presently occupy the following positions are hereby delegated the authority to authorize the disclosure of classified information to an individual or individuals who are otherwise not eligible for access but have a compelling need-to-know in order to mitigate an imminent threat to life or in defense of the homeland:

- Commissioners
- Executive Director for Operations
- Deputy Executive Director for Materials, Waste, Research, State, Tribal, Compliance, Administration, and Human Capital Programs, Office of the Executive Director for Operations
- Deputy Executive Director for Reactor and Preparedness Programs, Office of the Executive Director for Operations
- Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation
- Director, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards
- Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response
- Deputy Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response
- Regional Administrator, Region IV

Personnel that presently occupy the aforementioned positions may not re-delegate this emergency authority. Emergency disclosures of classified information shall be made only in accordance with Title 32 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 2001.52 in order to minimize the classified information that is disclosed under these circumstances and the number of individuals who receive it. Such disclosures shall be reported promptly to the originator of the classified information in accordance with 32 CFR 2001.52. Information disclosed under this emergency authority shall not be deemed declassified as a result of such disclosure or subsequent use by a recipient.
