On page 2, the use location for item 6.E (Y-90 Sir-tex) is listed as storage only, but we would like to use it in a main campus cathlab room; mean while item 6.F (Sr-90) is missing which should be in storage only; please help us to make correction on this and help identify any support document may be needed. (such as floormap for the cathlab room)?
2. On page3. section 12, medical physicists (item 12.D, supposedly) for both Tea Shi and Jing Wang have a material and use as "Cesium-137 for calibration of instrument", we were questioned about this item on a recent inspection. Could you help us to better understand the scope and requirement for this

item? Per inspector, we would not need this item, but we'd like to have a second opinion before we proceed.
