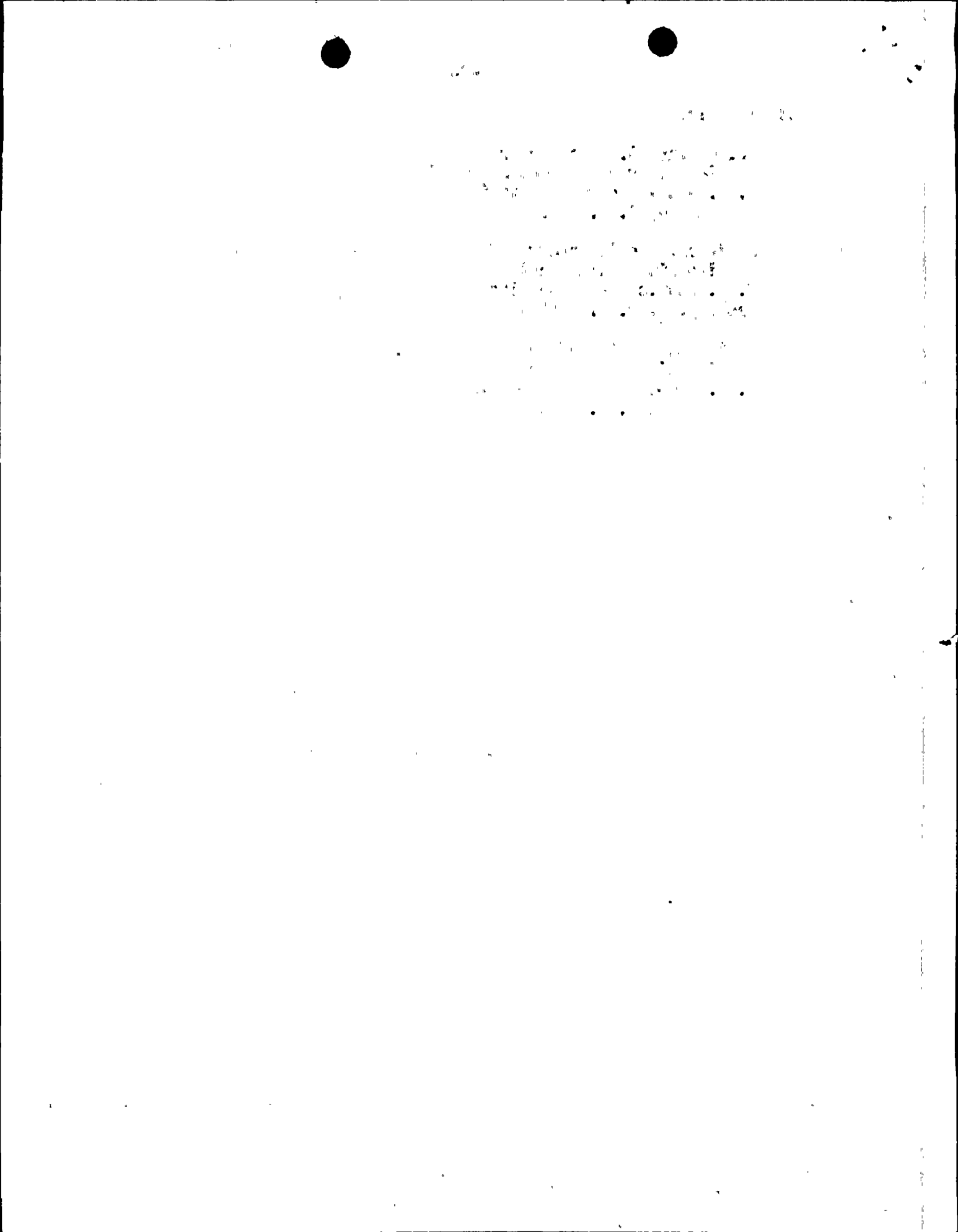

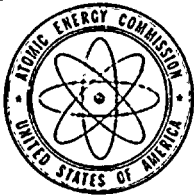

MEETING WITH NIAGARA MOHAWK POWER CORPORATION ON DECEMBER 11, 1972

At the meeting the staff discussed with the applicant various aspects of Appendix C to his PSAR. The applicant was requested to clarify a number of design criteria applied to plant components and systems. These clarifications will be reflected in amendments submitted to the Docket.

As a result of the meeting the applicant will further study the criteria applied to instruments and service air components which performed a safety related function as well as the cooling lines leading to the reactor coolant pumps and pump motors. Clarifications will be incorporated into the PSAR.
