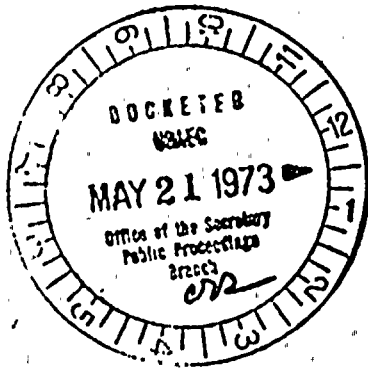





AFFIDAVIT OF SUBMISSION



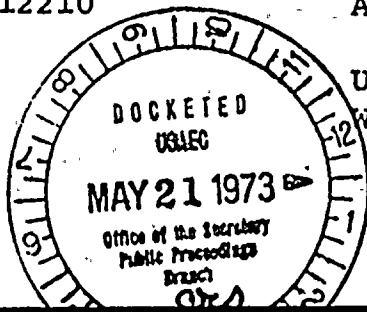


