Pursuant to your letter of July 27, 1972, we hereby submit certain additional information relative to the cost-benefit analysis of alternate sites and energy sources. As you have requested previously, we are submitting 200 copies of this information at this time. An additional 100 copies will be retained by Niagara Mohawk for submission at some later time when you request them.

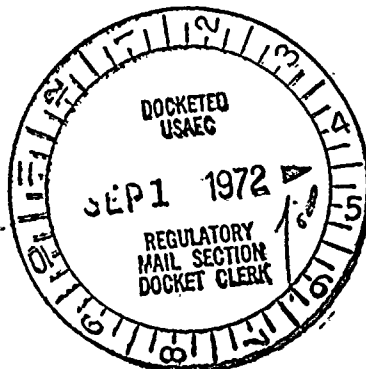

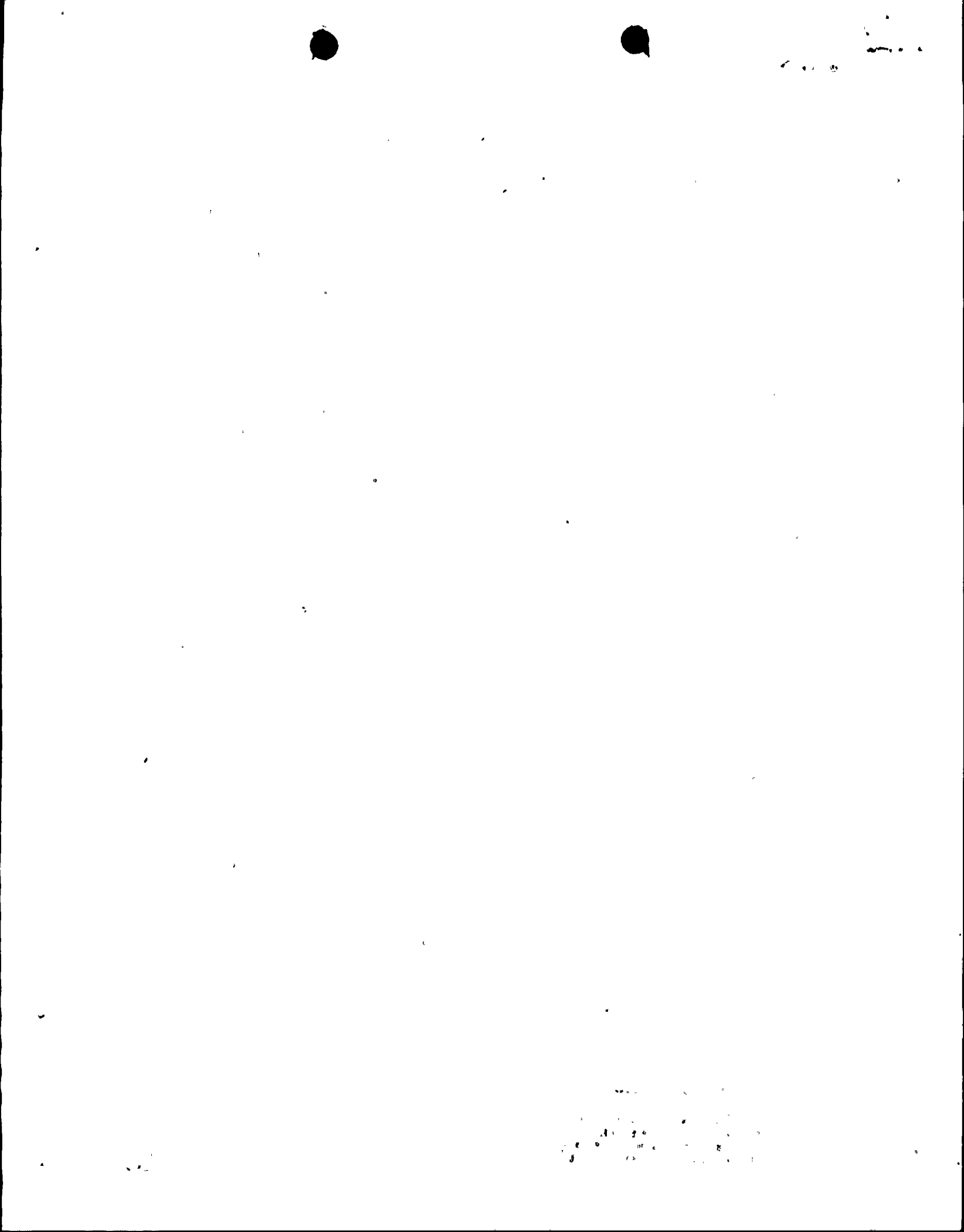
