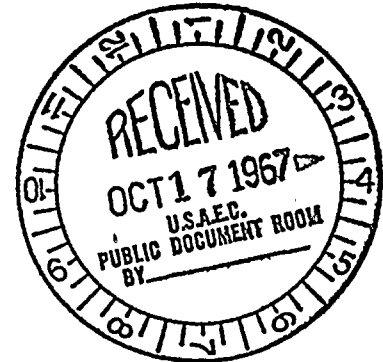

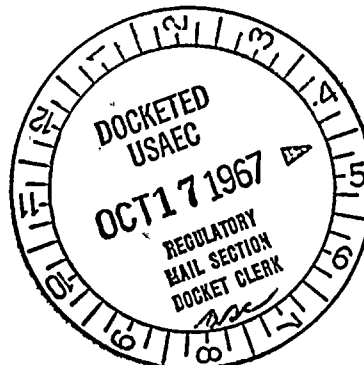

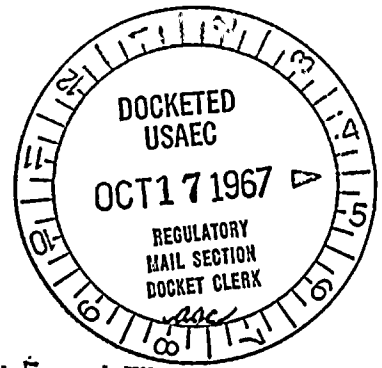

Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, Applicant in the above-captioned proceeding, hereby requests that Paragraph 2.A. of its Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-16 be amended to provide that the latest date for completion of its Nine Mile Point facility be August 1, 1968. In support of this request Applicant states that the delays it has experienced are the result of the existence of a serious lack of available skilled manpower, and of the necessity for extended analysis and investigation of the emergency core cooling systems and other safeguard features.

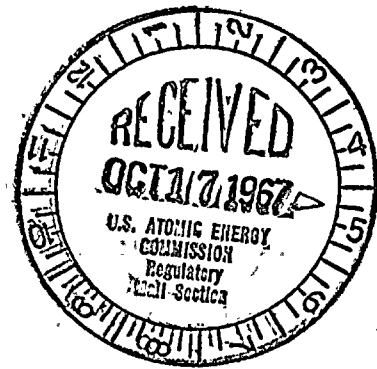
